School Advisory Council (SAC) MINUTES
February 25, 2019

1. Welcome: Nina Cohen welcomed and opened meeting.
2. January minutes were reviewed. Mary Ellen Pinzon motioned to accept, Nydia Chin seconded.
3. Nydia Chin, our Equity Liaison, presented our School Equity Plan. She reviewed our Mission and Vision statements. She gave examples of each of the goals of the plan. 1) Teachers are using books/literacy lessons to expose students to other cultures and learning other teaching methods at PLC. 2) To foster and promote friendly and culturally work and learning environment, bulletin boards are posted in the cafeteria and around the school. 3) Teachers have been instructed in translating documents on Microsoft and Parent trainings (Family Tech Night) have been offered in Spanish. 4. Principal's Sharing:
 - Mr. Henning meets with Construction Team every other Wednesday. He does not have finalized dates at this time but has been told work will take place after 3 pm once it gets started.
 - Mr. Henning congratulated Ms. Thomas and the aftercare team on the review. They received an excellent review in 12/13 areas. The 13th area was out of their control and had to do with a county repair on the SOMAT machine and the situation has been rectified.
 - Mr. Henning also spoke about the new policies from the County which refer to "Safer Spaces" and "Emergency Codes Prevention & Preparedness. He is awaiting the "designated County Team" to come to our school to review our campus.
5. Mary Ellen Pinzon proposed the money from the Bond, originally designated for picnic tables, be moved to purchase technology equipment. MaryAnne McCullough seconded. The SAC committee voted unanimously to approve. Gail Applebaum asked if monies can be used to build an awning for Rainy Day dismissals but Mr. Henning explained it is too cost prohibitive for these funds and that we have explored this in the past but can not move forward on this at this time.
6. Nina reminded the committee that we need volunteers for Kindergarten swimming and FSA proctors. If you are available, please contact Ms. Cohen or Ms. Donahue.

SAC adjourned at 7:32 am


