

School Advisory Council (SAC) MINUTES
October 22, 2018

1. Welcome: Nina Cohen welcomed and opened meeting. She asked all members to sign in and fill out survey.
2. September minutes were reviewed. M. McCullough motioned to accept, Kristen Blankenship seconded.
3. Mr. Henning gave his report:
 - First quarter is over, everything is going well
 - 187 laptops were ordered for students and 10 for teachers-this was funded through "enhancement monies"
 - The marquee signage is still awaiting approval. He was asked to set aside an additional 8,000 to cover costs.
 - The Fall Festival will be this Friday, Oct. 26, 2018
4. School Improvement Plan: Ms. Cohen reviewed how to find and look at the 2018-2019 school year SIP. She gave printed directions to all members. She reviewed survey results and Best Practice #3, Learning Targets and Best Practice #4. She explained that each school is placed in a SES band (we are compared with schools with similar Free/Reduced lunch numbers)-we are 38/156 schools in our band.
5. Adjourned SAC at 7:35 am
6. SAF Meeting: Lynn Powell was nominated (Ms. Applebaum motioned, everyone was in favor) to be co-chair of SAF with Ms. Carter. Ms. Carter reported that SAF is conducting the "Wednesday start" survey and reminded everyone to complete it before they leave the meeting. She also explained that the County had conducted a School Safety Assessment and it will be released in January. The Preliminary findings focused on security cameras at all schools and the possible monitoring of cameras at a central county location. SAF Adjourned at 7:46 a.m.
