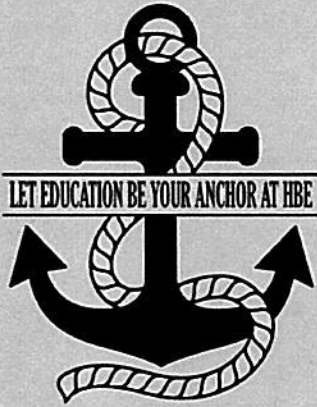

Welcome

Principal's Update

Guest Speaker

- **Desiree' Tanke and Dr. Daniel Shapiro.** Dr. Shapiro is the School Counseling Specialist at the elementary level and school counseling and BRACE.
- Mindfulness: Be in the moment.
- **Dr. Shapiro:** When a child is upset, the first thing to do is speak in a calm voice and get them to relax and calm down.
- Triangle Breathing: Take a deep breath in. Hold the breath and exhale.
- Recognized Ms. Garcia and her community outreach efforts with our ELL students and parents.
- **Desiree' Tanke: Fixed Mindset:** Not in control of your abilities. **Growth Mindset:** Believe you are in control of your abilities.
- Research shows that when students adapt a growth mindset, their achievement scores increase, and they deal better with adversity.
- Parents can praise the process rather than the product. Praise the process, not the grades. Change your narrative. Change your child's thinking. The Power of Yet is a TED Talk video with Dr. Carol Dwek.
- **Dr. Shapiro:** We are here because we want to do everything possible for our children. Equity: Kids are all very different. They need different things in order to thrive and meet their needs.

SAC/SAF

- **Kathy Wicker, Curriculum Facilitator:**
- Ms. Unger-Fink Motioned to approve the minutes and was second by Ms. Dehart.
- Family Life and Human Sexuality Curriculum. Please spread the word and let other parents know where they can find the curriculum. The curriculum is based on National Standards. Statistics show a need for the curriculum to be taught. Parents must make a written request to the school for their child to be exempt from the curriculum. This form is in the Student Code of Conduct and can be found on browardprevention.org. Broward County is #2 in the Nation in new HIV cases.
- Review of the community resources, for example; The Youth Health Guide and 211 (FACE).
- Review of website to access SIP and the components of SIP (Attendance plan, School-wide positive behavior plan, SEL, FACE, etc.)
- PTA, SAC, and SAF are 3 ways to get involved. Purpose of SAC is to monitor the School Improvement Plan. We need people to get involved in SAC next year. We need all the demographics represented. If you are interested, we meet once per month.
