Bond Money

- We chose to change blinds, upgrade the playground, put up a shade structure on intermediate playground, and install microphones
- Blinds are costing more because of the issues with the company originally installing it.
- We will vote on taking out the microphones, so we can finish the blinds.
- Ms. Daub motions to vote. Ms. Marcus seconds.
- Unanimous vote to install the blinds.

2017-2018 School Grade

- Need 62% to receive an A. Last year we received a B, as we had 61%
- Ms. Cunningham went over the data to explain how we achieved the 61%
- Need to target 5th grade lowest quartile, as they count in 6 categories and science

- We were at 63% in 2015-2016; 67% in 2016-2017; and fell to 61% last year
- We need to focus on the lowest quartile across the board. We have put a lot of resources into this. We had data chats yesterday.
- All teachers are aware of the data for their individual students
- Broke down the individual grade levels from 2015 to 2018.
- We must focus on data and use it to drive our instruction.
- Overall there was a big drop in 4th grade math in several schools

iReady

- We had the representative here last week to address questions
- Question regarding iReady math. Ms. Cunningham explained that we do not have the technology funds for that, but we will be looking into another program to enrich our students.

SAF

- Proposed calendars
- They wanted to know how people felt about each option
- Option 1: start on a Wednesday so high school exams will be complete before winter break
- Option 2: starts on a Monday
- The difference is starting on the 12th as opposed to the 14th
- It was decided that we would be flexible at HBE

PTA

- Tiki Ice this Wednesday
- Fall Festival is Oct 5
- Tickets will go on sale next week for stations and food. Silent auction will be held the night of the festival. Must be present to win the basket
