- Need 62% to receive an A. Last year we received a B, as we had 61%

- Need to target 5<sup>th</sup> grade lowest quartile, as they count in 6 categories and science

- We were at 63% in 2015-2016; 67% in 2016-2017; and fell to 61% last year
- We need to focus on the lowest quartile across the board. We have put a lot of resources into this. We had data chats yesterday.
- All teachers are aware of the data for their individual students
- · Broke down the individual grade levels from 2015 to 2018.
- · We must focus on data and use it to drive our instruction.
- Overall there was a big drop in 4th grade math in several schools

# iReady

- We had the representative here last week to address questions
- Question regarding iReady math. Ms. Cunningham explained that we do not have the technology funds for that, but we will be looking into another program to enrich our students.

#### SAF
