SAF

- FSA and EOC tests have been pushed back. Concerned that the reports will not
 come out until after report cards. The county would like feedback. Ms. Wicker
 feels pushing the FSA back is o.k., because it gives teachers more time to teach.
 Every student takes an end of the year test to make sure there is back-up. The
 discussion yielded a consensus that the teachers are o.k. with having the extra
 time before the FSA.

School Improvement Plan

- Review of SEL Plan: Every school is required to have a plan. We need to teach social emotional learning. Teach kids to talk to each other and solve conflicts. 6 competencies: Self-awareness, social-awareness, responsible decision-making, self-management, and relationship skills. There are standards for social emotional learning. Mr. Sanford started a program called Sanford Harmony to help teach these skills. Ms. Tanke and Ms. Daub attended a Sanford Harmony training. HBE has Sanford Harmony kits and Ms. Daub sends ideas to incorporate into the day. "Start with Hello" campaign originated from Sandy Hook. We did some activities to promote this. We started the Save Club. Student council reps will be in the Save Club to do activities that promote social emotional learning. Before you speak think of the following things: Is it true? Is it kind? Is it necessary? School board would like us to do a program like Best Buddies, where students build relationships with special needs students.
- Ms. Tanke has many resources for parents and students
- Ms. Wicker went over some social emotional learning activities recommended by the county. Many students at HBE use "safe space" where students know who they can go to.
- We need to make the following corrections on SEL plan: academic measurement; revisit standards to include specific lessons
- Black history, Hispanic Heritage, Women's History, and the Holocaust must be taught. We are trying to integrate these into their curriculum. Does anybody have any ideas? Send Ms. Wicker or Ms. Tanke an email with ideas. We are open to suggestions. Some suggestions were: essay and poster contest; have a

- student dress up as a famous figure and go on morning announcements to see if students can guess who it is; door decorating contest
- iReady Diagnostic will run from 12/3-12/21. The information helps us monitor student progress.
- Literacy week is in January. Team leaders are coming up with a plan. We are looking into a vocabulary parade. We want to encourage reading for enjoyment.
