Hawkes Bluff Elementary School Advisory November 5, 2018 Minutes

Welcome

- Mrs. Wicker called the meeting to order at 1:33 p.m.

Approval of Minutes

- Motion to approve minutes by Ms. Shasa

From the Office;

- Ms. Petrone wants us to remind parents who have not updated their online forms, they must do this as soon as possible. We are trying to go paperless. Please help us remind parents.

School Improvement Plan

- Primary purpose of SAC is to develop the School Improvement Plan (SIP)
- You should have received the SAC and SAF bylaws
- The SIP plan is a public document, and everyone has access to all SIP plans in the county.
- Ms. Wicker went over the directions on how to find the SIP plan online. If you look at it now, you will see last year's plans, as they were due at the end of October and have not been uploaded yet. Please give it a couple of weeks, and the new plans should be up.
- The first part of the plan is PLC's (Professional Learning Communities). Teachers work in teams and use student data to develop strategies to improve classroom practices. Our focus this year is ELA K-5 and ESE. We must make growth.
- The next part of the plan is RTI (Response to Intervention). If there are any academic or behavioral concerns, we meet with administration, counselors, teachers, parents, etc. to see what we can do to help these students
- Ms. Wicker showed the School Counseling Activities
- Explanation of MTSS Plan. We look at our weaknesses and come up with an action plan to improve. Progress is monitored.
- Schoolwide Behavior Plan: Behavior committee meets to determine plan. We have schoolwide goals and have incorporated CHAMPs into the plan.
- Social Emotional Learning (SEL) plan. We are using Sanford Harmony. Ms. Tanke and Ms. Daub have attended workshops and are working to ensure that teachers are incorporating activities into their daily routines.
- Attendance Plan: We are fortunate, because we do not have many issues with attendance. We do have a plan for habitually absent students.
- FACE Plan: How school deals with community issues. We have helped with school uniforms, backpacks, healthcare, etc. Community members should be made aware that we are here and there are many resources available to help them.
- Ms. Wicker shared survey results. The parents and teachers seemed to be consistent with each other. She explained that the student scale is different than the parent and student scale.
- SAC composition shows how we are broken down demographically. We are required to upload all minutes, our bylaws, and meeting dates.

- Goals, Strategies, and Activities: ELA goals for FSA were chosen due to our decrease in scores. You will find best practices listed (use of BAS data, district standards, utilization of PLC agenda form, participation in professional development, Singapore math, etc.) Progress monitoring through data chats, STEMScope, fluency assessments, monthly PLC's etc. The county is pushing CRA methodology.
- Explained where you can find the resource documents

- Currently, all schools have a different Wi-Fi password. The county is trying to put a system in place to have the ability to access Wi-Fi in all schools.
- Ms. Unger-Fink sent a PDF of expression inventory to Ms. Wicker and Ms. Garfinkel.
