**I. North Area Advisory (NAA) Updates**

- a) **School Calendar**- Will be voted by the county in December for the 2019-2020 school year.
- b) **Homework Makeup Policy**- It is being reviewed in the high schools. Some teachers are following the policy while others are not. If parents are having concerns with their child's teacher, they are to notify the school first
- c) **Bullying**- It is occurring at a younger age. Some parents feel that they are not getting the support from the school.
- d) **Fire Alarms**- Fire Alarms need to be uniformed across the district. Need to hold then clear. Some schools are not following this process and are going to clear while there are still staff and students evacuating.
- e) **Nurse**- The request to have a nurse at all schools was approved but tabled for the time being.
- f) **Substitute Teachers**- The district is experiencing a substitute shortage. The pay increase for subs which is hoped to help with the shortage was tabled. The number of subs currently working in schools are low and all are booked with jobs leaving schools with having to get creative with the shortage.
