Close out of 2017-2018 School Improvement Plan – According to Florida School Grade Calculations, Embassy Creek Elementary demonstrated an overall 10% increase in total points earned, awarding Embassy a continued School Letter Grade of "A". In addition, the after-school Science Camp had a positive impact on 5th grade Science proficiency by contributing to an increase of 1 percentage point from 77% proficiency to 78% proficiency.
