I. WELCOME

Ms. Lesch called the meeting to order at 3:12 P.M. Those in attendance were welcomed and packets were distributed.

II. REVIEW MINUTES OF OCTOBER 25, 2018 MEETING

III. SIP INITIATIVES

PROFESSIONAL LEARNING COMMUNITIES:
