#### Welcome

The assembly was called to order at 7:44am and Mrs. Lawrence opened the meeting with a welcome.

### **Guest Speakers**

Mrs. Lawrence opened the floor for guest speakers, there were no guest speakers.

### Items for Approval

• March 2019 SAC Minutes — A quorum was present and minutes were approved. Ms. Powell made a motion to accept the minutes with the approved revisions. The motion was second by Ms. Stephens. Voting members voted unanimously to approve the motion.

## Principal's Report

Mrs. Lawrence indicated the account balances remain the same. She opened the floor for questions, there were no questions asked.

#### **Old Business**

School Choice Enhancement Project (SCEP) Updates - (Mrs. Lawrence)

- Mrs. Lawrence initiated the conversation to review the needs assessment for the SCEP. She displayed a visual on the Recordex board for the audience to review. A discussion was conducted and priority items were highlighted according to audience feedback.
- There were a few items that were still awaiting quotes from the vendors.
- A question was asked in reference to the number of televisions that were needed. It was indicated that 25 televisions would need to be purchased.
- Ms. Wimberly suggested the school purchase projectors instead of televisions because projectors would save money and save space.
- It is not recommended to spend over \$27,000 to purchase a digital marquee board because it could only be viewed when the school gates are opened.
- Star-up supplies will be included with the purchase on an ID machine and additional supplies will have to be purchased from the general budget.
- Discussion was held regarding which equipment to purchase or replace on the playgrounds. It was suggested that new equipment be purchased for the Kindergarten-2<sup>nd</sup> grade playground and the slide be replaced for the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade playground.
- The needs assessment list will be condensed to generate two ballots for voting.

#### **New Business**

- Mrs. Lawrence presented a proposal to allocate \$700.00 to defray the cost of purchasing student agendas for the 2019-20 school year. Ms. Shelly Ann Johnson made a motion to accept the proposal. The motion was second by Ms. Moore. Voting members voted unanimously to approve the motion and accept the proposal.
- Mrs. Lawrence presented a proposal to allocate \$2,500.00 to defray the cost of
  purchasing student incentives/rewards for the 2019-20 school year. Ms. Shelly Ann
  Johnson made a motion to accept the proposal. The motion was second by Ms. Jones.
  Voting members voted unanimously to approve the motion and accept the proposal.
- Ms. Greer reviewed the School Wide Discipline Plan and shared that the number of referrals has increased from last year and a positive intervention program will be added.
