Call to Order:

A meeting of the Palm Cove Elementary School Advisory Council was held in the Cafeteria on January 24, 2019. Chair Kimberly Charpentier called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Jennifer Alfred will record minutes for this meeting.

Minutes:

The minutes from the November meeting were reviewed by the committee. A motion was made to accept the minutes as is by Jennifer Alfred. Second by Loan Rodriguez. All were in favor. Motion passed.

Old Business:

- 1. FSA Camp is in full swing at Palm Cove. Students were targeted based on data collected. Camps are Reading, Math, Science, and Writing weekly.
- 2. BSA Testing will begin at the end of the month. Parents will receive a phone link message and it will be posted on our website. Classroom teachers will use the data to prepare our students for the FSA test.

New Business:

- New PTA at Palm Cove. Our old PTA was dissolved a few years ago due to lack of participation. Coach Beiber and Coach Charpentier contacted the PTA and representatives are here tonight to begin our new chapter. They will collect \$5 from each parent who wants to participate (minimum of 10 parents needed) and then officers will be elected.
- 2. Palm Cove will be having a collaborative visit to see our math initiatives. Visitors from the county will be here to see our math block.
- 3. SIP Mid-Year Review was passed out to all members present and the parents in the audience. Coach Charpentier reviewed our present levels of performance and the document. There were no parent concerns or questions.

Reports:

- 1. Principal Report: Mrs. Davida Johnson, the school principal, gave an update on school events and welcomed everyone. She reviewed our instructional plans this year and goals for the FSA and moving our school up to the letter grade of a B.
- 2. Title One: Kim Charpentier gave an update on the Title One plan. Our binder is in compliance with the state at this time with our e-binder. All parent compacts are collected for this school year. The Title 1 survey will be available tonight to finalize any parents who still would like to participate. Also, we are taking any volunteers for the Annual Parent Seminar on February 2nd. We still need two more parents and we got them signed up tonight. Our additional curriculum materials that were ordered with our money have arrived and are being used for FSA camps and in the classrooms.

The floor was opened to the members and guests for any questions and/or comments. Everyone was pleased and there were no questions for the committee or administration. The Literacy Night will begin when the meeting is closed. Parents wishing to join the PTA will also meet with Coach Beiber and the PTA representatives.
