Minutes:

Old Business:

- 1. FSA Camp continues for ELA, Math, and Science for the next two weeks. Writing camp is now over due to the students completing the FSA Writing test earlier this month.
- 2. FSA ELA 3rd Grade and FSA Writing 4th and 5th grade testing completed on April 2-3.
