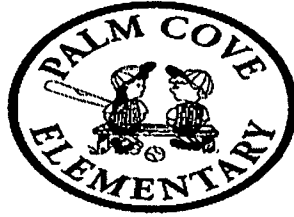

SAC Minutes – October 24, 2018.

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Palm Cove Elementary School Advisory Council was held in the Cafeteria on October 24, 2018. Chair Kimberly Charpentier called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM. Jennifer Alfred will record minutes for this meeting.

Minutes:

The minutes from the September meeting were reviewed by the committee. A motion was made to accept the minutes as is by Jennifer Alfred. Second by Loan Rodriguez. All were in favor. Motion passed.

Old Business:

1. Read for the Record is tomorrow at Palm Cove. We have volunteers in all kindergarten classrooms as well as Pre-K and ASD Kindergarten to read to the students. All children will get a copy of the book "Maybe Something Beautiful" to take home after the event. Vice Mayor Tom Good will be one of the volunteers in attendance.
2. The flyers went out for our annual storybook parade next Wednesday on Halloween day. Students are encouraged to dress in a costume from a storybook. The parade details are on the website, flyer, and home link phone calls that have gone out.
3. FLKRS Kindergarten State Testing is complete and 100% of students were tested successfully.

New Business:

1. Vote in new SAC members: New members, Jennifer Hickey, Herbert Palmer, Nigel Bennett, Sherill Pearlene were voted in by the current members of the committee. Noted that we replaced member Sheri Trammell who left the school, Robert Beiber, who resigned, and Dominik Elmasian who resigned. First: Kimberly Charpentier, second: Jennifer Hickey, All were in favor.
2. Review and Approve the SIP Goals for the 2018-19 School Year: Copies were made of the SIP plan and passed out to all members present. They are also posted on the school website. They were reviewed by all members of the committee and voted in for the school year. First: Jill Villar, second: Loan Rodriguez, All were in favor.
3. Cadre Update: our school is now part of Cadre 10 and our director is Dr. Hall. This is a change from last year as we were part of Cadre 5. The district reorganized our area.
4. I Ready Computer Program Update: The program is up and running as we have completed our Diagnostic 1 testing on all students. Parents are having some log in issues at home and we are support them through additional resources on our website and assisting parents in the front office with technical guidance. Students are still completing 45 minutes of both math and reading each week in the classroom as part of their instructional plan.

Reports:

1. Principal Report: Mrs. Davida Johnson, the school principal, gave an update on school events and welcomed everyone. She reviewed our instructional plans this year and goals for the FSA and moving our school up to the letter grade of a B.
2. Title One: Kim Charpentier gave an update on the Title One plan. Our binder is in compliance with the state at this time and we are still collecting the parent compacts from parents. We are still in need of parent volunteers for the parent engagement academy.

The floor was opened to the members and guests for any questions and/or comments. Everyone was happy to be here and there were no questions for the committee or administration. Batty Bingo will begin when the meeting is closed.
