# **Assistant Principal Report**

SIP Goal is to increase student achievement in science from 64% of our students in grade 5 at level 3 proficiency or higher to 70% of students at level 3 or higher. What are we doing to get there? Each teacher at each grade level has been made aware of standards. K-4 students have taken a pretest to assess knowledge and gains. Grade 4 also is doing a mid-year assessment. These assessments are measuring all 4 areas of science (life, physical, earth/space, and nature and process). Grades 3-5 are receiving strategic professional development once a month we have grade level trainings with new curriculum, planning, resources etc. We are using a 5 E model to teach science. Engage, Explore, Explain, Elaborate, Evaluate. There has also been a district science coach that has been coming out to help make lesson plans and units with teachers. Right now we are at 1/2 time. BSA for grade 5 is next week. Data will be here soon.

Parents recommended syllabus to come home to make them aware or science standards being taught. Due to each class taking different amounts of time to finish each unit teachers will need to communicate with parents. A parent also asked for a link to standards on our school website. Mr. Redshaw mentioned parents can also download the free Florida Standards app.
