School Improvement Plan Updates:

Title 1 Addendum with input from parents: Parents were given the opportunity to provide input on the contents of the plan. No suggestions were made. Parents were given information about the plan; a hard copy was offered to anyone who wanted one.

School Accountability Funds:

Proposal to purchase guided reading materials from Fountas & Pinnell Classroom to increase ELA proficiency. Intervention block uses LLI. These materials would support Tier 1 instruction. Additional school funds are being used to purchase first and third grade kits. Proposal is brought forth to purchase second grade materials through SAC accountability funds. Each grade level kit comes with 200 titles, with 6 copies of each title. The eleven members of the composition team in attendance took a vote. By a unanimous vote, all composition team members are in favor of using SAC accountability funds to purchase a second grade Fountas & Pinnell Classroom Guided Reading Library.
