1. Meeting was called to order at 2:33 P.M.
2. Quorum Established
3. The minutes were approved. Motioned by Dr. Peralta and seconded by Mrs. Bahamon.
4. The agenda was approved. Motioned by Mrs. Diaz and seconded by Ms. Linero. With correction made to the November date.
5. Motion to release Accountability Funds for Coaching in Academics camp, approved by all in attendance.
6. Camp Updates:
  - iReady Camp begins on January 28, 2019
  - CIA Camp will begin February 26, 2019 and will be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2-3 PM.
  - Language Enrichment Camp for ESOL students is funded by Title 3
6. Principal's Report
  - Invention Convention was a great success, with over 600 in attendance
  - Roof Permit is to be approved for February 2019
  - Administration and Pines Police Dept. are working to coordinate a Parent Night, to educate parents on Threats and Safety as a Community, this is a Parent Only event.
  - Vaping has now entered elementary schools, not just middle schools, grades affected are 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students.
  - Thank you to Mrs. Simmonds and Mr. Dieujuste for their continued work in mentoring our students, not just those at risk, but taking the initiative to support their needs.
  - Literacy Week will begin next week, January 28-February 1. Lots of fun activities have been scheduled for the students for the week. Theme "Spreading Literacy one view at a Time."
  - February 14<sup>th</sup> is the Remembrance Day for the District, we will follow the schedule that has been set by the district, at 10:17 a.m. we will hold a moment of silence for the victims. Teachers will be given the options on how they would like to handle the day.
  - MSD Act is to make us aware of Mental Wellness, on February 14<sup>th</sup>, service projects are only for MSD students.

## 7. SAF Report

- Donna Bouch will speak at the January 25<sup>th</sup> meeting, addressing lower attendance in all public schools. Looking into Academics and Attendance. For district services to help int these patterns.
- February 1<sup>st</sup>, Take Your Child to Work
- February 2<sup>nd</sup>, Signature Grand "Title One" workshop
- Parents have stressed to the district about the need to do "Drills", the MSD Act requires that each school must conduct 10 (ten) drills.

- School Calendar has been released for the 2019/2020 year.
