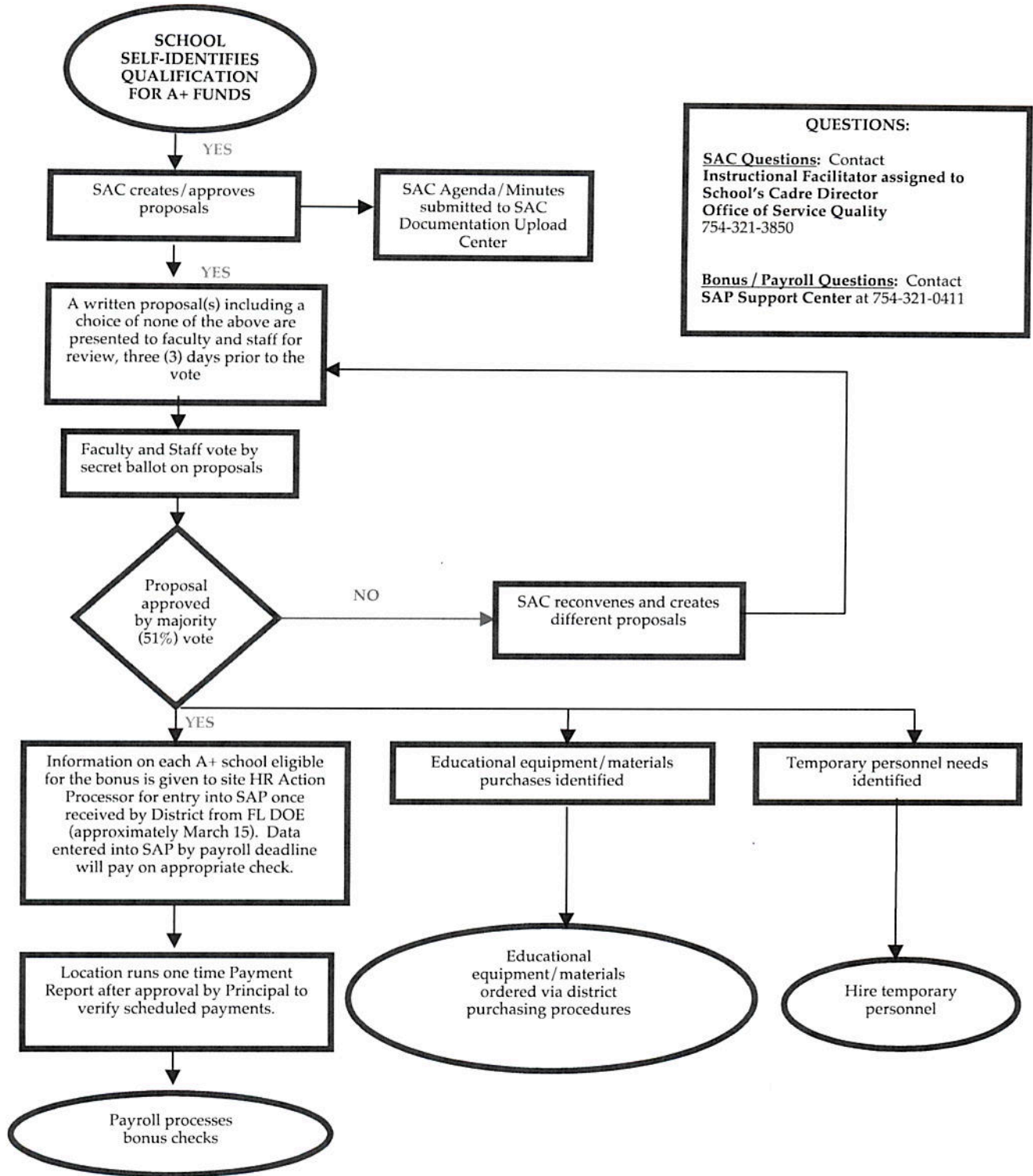

4. Quorum was established by 51% of members in attendance

5. SMART Bond Presentation; District Based Program that was voted on in the 2014 Election.

6. Approval of By-Laws for 2018-19 S.A.C. Committee

7. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:
 - SPE has regained our "A" for the 2017-18 school year, effective July 1st, 2018
 - Projected numbers for the 2018-19 school year has been exceeded based from current registrations for the new school year.
 - SPE anticipates more registration after the Labor Day holiday
 - Hired Resource Teacher for the class size limit
 - VPK class has been a success thanks to our moms' who worked tirelessly to assist in getting the VPK word out, this program is fully funded and supplied by the District
 - The VPK goal is to have two (2) classrooms for the following school year of 2019-20

- SPE was able to purchase extra computer carts with extra funds from the previous year
- Music Bond is scheduled for completion for the 2018-19 school year with the addition of a full class set Keyboard Lab
- SMART Bond money; School Choice vote to the board; Playground \$50,000 Marquee of \$30,000; Sunscreen/Roof for the Blacktop Court. The cost is much higher than originally anticipated
- New roof slated for summer 2019, patch work is currently being done in areas of immediate need, and until the roof is approved and initiated.
- The SMART Bond funds will be voted on by the SAC Committee members along with ideas on what the funds should be used for.
- New SAC members; welcome MR. Ricardo Ponce
- Two (2) meeting dates have been updated
- S.I.P.; new goals have been met by 25% growth in proficiency. Increased in weakness was a success in improving strength, Data should be available by the next meeting.
- Testing is now Paper-Based, I-Ready books purchased to assist with the education standards for the state.
- Small Groups are encouraged to help address students' individual academic needs
