 - Motion to approve Mrs. Nanni, second motion Mrs. Black
- III. Principal's Report – Ms. Burgess
 - Volunteer Appreciation Day May 21
 - Thanks to all our parents who volunteer to help support our school
 - Most appreciated
 - Budget meeting two weeks ago
 - We are not Title I for the 2019-20 school year
 - We had 48% FRL during the second FTE – it needed to be 50%
 - We will work on our free and reduced lunch to make sure everyone that needs the resource and is eligible applies.
 - Some parents might not feel comfortable applying. Be mindful of them
 - Staff reduction; teachers as well as teacher assistant
 - Continue as a Leader in Me school
 - Specials next year will be Art, Music, P.E., Media, Computers
 - It was suggested that Debate Special replace Synergy . Debate supports the Listening and Speaking Standards and the Leader in Me Program
 - **Vote was called by Ms. Baston to have Debate as a special .**
 - **All members were in favor**
 - Classrooms are participating in a variety of year end assessments - i-Ready, BAS, End of Book Tests
 - Safety
 - Ms. Burgess attended a district safety meeting- we have updated security this year and remain safe
 - Extra walkies, intercom, security cameras, campus monitor were some of the updates
 - Smart Bond Update - During the summer, the playground will be completed; the 800 building has gone out for rebidding (windows, floors, A/C)
 - Accomplishments
 - FSA Testing is completed
 - Fox Care Summer Camp is here this summer
 - Breakfast and lunch included
 - Academic activity in the morning

- Fun activity in the afternoon
- Register for camp today
- After school tutoring camps; \$40,000 was spent
- Accountability funds are still available for this year. First grade has researched and found materials to support Phonics instruction. They have visited 2 schools using the program. This is a weakness that is also seen as older students go through the RTI process. The purchase of Foundations would support tier 1 instruction for all students as well as target specific deficiencies. If materials are purchased, the program will be used for all classes in a Walk to Read style with students grouped by ability. Mrs. Black and Mrs. Andrews suggested that we spend the funds. **Ms. Baston called for a vote to spend accountability funds on the Foundations Kits. \$10-12,000 is needed. The SAC voted unanimously to fund this initiative.**

IV. Lighthouse Team Report

- Mrs. Berg and Mrs. Alberico visited Eagle Point, Leader In Me school. They saw great ideas to possibly use at Fox Trail
- Student lighthouse team met with Ms. Burgess at the end of the year Talked about infusing students in assemblies
- Student Lighthouse Team led Rounding up Leaders, (formerly Kindergarten Round-Up),
 - Awesome job with student involvement
 - Students welcomed the parents and led the entire day
 - They explained the rotation of the different stations; Stations Were: 7 habits, PTSA, Transportation, Fox Care. Student translators were available to assist parents
 - Kate Andrews, Lighthouse Team student shared her responsibility with the committee
