## Welcome/Pledge

#### Introductions

Yvonne Lopez from the City of Coconut Creek and 2 11<sup>th</sup> grade students introduced themselves.

### Principal's Report

Monarch administered the PSAT today and only 86 percent of the students showed up to take the test.

The homecoming game is on 10/11/18 and the dance is on 10/13/18.

Approximately 800 students will attend the dance.

Monarch now has a Black Student Union club on campus. The first meeting was well attended, and Mr. Watkins from Diversity presented information at the meeting.

### **School Improvement Plan**

The plan is still a work in progress. RTI dates need to be added. The RTI plan has been completed and the Attendance and Behavior plans are being addressed.

#### **New Business**

Request from Accountability funds for Math Tutoring after school - Mr. Neer explained in order to further assist students with their math skills in Algebra and Geometry he would like to offer the after-school tutoring and pay the teachers their hourly rate. He is looking at having 2 teachers run the program.

Request from Accountability funds for WriteScore – Dr. Sweeting-Miller explained that the program is designed for the students to have practice in Reading and

Writing and offers scripted feedback to the students. This allows the teachers to make adjustments to their lesson plans and help the students master the skills necessary to do well on the assessments. Each part of the program cost about \$5,000. We are looking at offering 2 Readings and 1 Writing or 1 Reading and 1 Writing.
