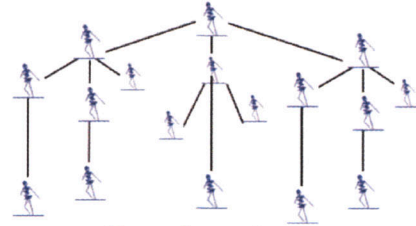

2. **Curriculum Committee Reports-**
 - a. Literacy- Mrs. Pinto:

 - Funding for Mrs. Pinto's donor's choose to have a little cub library where students can have access to books in addition to our media center has been met.
 - Mrs. Pinto will be working with one of the students from Mrs. Roulhac's class who chose something similar to this as her service learning project.
 - Moving forward, Writing will be a focus for the committee as we make sure all writing standards are being mastered as students move up the grades.
 - Fourth grade writing seminar is going great and will continue.
 - Students are being monitored on their iReady usage and growth.

 - b. Science- Mrs. Garcia shares which STEM project each grade level is working on in preparation for Science night on January 30.

 - c. Math- Mrs. Roulhac shares the chapter/skill each grade is working on. She also shares that Math Team will start meeting and preparing in December. Mrs. Roulhac also shares about the Toy Drive taking place in her class as a service learning project.
