

Panther Run Elementary SAC Meeting Minutes— March 20, 2019

Mrs. Garcia filed motion to call the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m. Mrs. Steffenson seconded the motion.

1. Approval of January minutes:

Motion to approve minutes by Mrs. Steffenson, seconded by Mr. Steffenson. All SAC members in favor.

2. SMART bond-

- Ms. Saef reviewed the SMART Bond process for Panther Run's \$100,000 discussed in February
- Mrs. Marleen Ghabi is present to explain SMART bond process. This part of the bond is the only part where the community has a say. Our goal today is to develop a ballot to present to our school community. She explained what we can and can't have on the ballot and some of the procedural rules.
- Proposals were generated and the group decided to go forward with the items below:

PROPOSAL 1:

- Safety/Security Enhancements A Phone (Camera/buzzer lock for Front Main Entrance Single Point of Entry door - \$10,000 & 2- Way Radios \$4000.00
- New Marquee – Approx. \$40,000
- Technology (Hardware (computers, laptops, recordex, etc & Software iReady) – remaining dollars \$37,00 - \$56,000

PROPOSAL 2:

- New Marquee – Approx. \$40,000
- Removal of carpet in Media & Front office and tile floors as replacement \$25,000
- New furniture Media Center \$35,000
- Motion to approve proposals by Mrs. Steffenson, seconded by Mrs. Squarini.
- Voting will take place in April with allotted time for community to review the proposals. Parents will have one vote per student, and staff members will have one vote. A staff member that is also a parent will vote as a parent.

3. Curriculum Committee Reports-

a. Science: Mrs. Garcia reports the current unit each grade level is working on:

- Kindergarten is working physical changes of matter.
- 1st grade is demonstrating and describing movement of objects.
- 2nd grade is studying life cycles.
- 3rd grade is studying animal adaptations.
- 4th grade is working on Earth and Space.
- 5th grade continues to work with Mrs. Garcia in extended science block as the science assessment is fast approaching. All students have been signed up for ScienceWorks and Legends of Learning to help them prepare for Science FSA. Log-in info is in student planners.

b. Math-

- Mrs. Roulhac reports that the intermediate grades are on crunch time in preparation of the Math FSA. Teachers are using unit reviewa, reteach, and countdowns to reinforce skills.
- Math Night at Target is on hold due to communication issues with Target.
- At recent Math meeting, Mrs. Roulhac was informed that the county is on hold for a new Math book adoption for the time being.
- Continue the use of iReady for 45 minutes each week.

c. Literacy-

- Crunch time with FSA around the corner for grades 3-5. Primary grades are also working on reviews for their end of year assessments.
- Writing FSA is on April 2 for 4th and 5th grade. ELA FSA is April 2 and 3rd for 3rd grade.
- BAS proficiency levels have improved school wide as a per our last assessment period.
- Seussville was a success.
