SCHOOL ADVISORY COUNCIL (SAC) MINUTES
November 28, 2018

Meeting started 2:32 PM

- I. Roll Call – we had 3 parents join us via telephone
- II. Approval of Minutes – approved with correction to Minutes instead of Agenda
- III. School Improvement Plan Update
 - Reviewed information from last month’s SAC meeting conversation about small group instruction, rock and roll reading and enrichment
 - Shared information regarding individual data chats with each teacher to discuss each of their students.
 - Title 1 funds are also being used to give each grade level team a planning day to give them time to work together and plan ahead for the remainder of the school year. This will help us impact student achievement in a positive way.
- IV. Before & After School Child Care (BASCC) Program
 - Schools have an option every year to either keep our own BASCC or hire a private company
 - Our school benefits from the proceeds and we work very closely with BASCC to help ensure everything is going smoothly.
 - Mrs. Ramirez is doing a great job as our new Aftercare Director and all inspections that have been done so far have been very good.
 - SAC was asked for feedback regarding our current program.
 - SAC approved our BASCC Program continue at Lakeside Elementary.
- V. Accountability Funds – Voting
 - We currently have \$11,201.96 to spend on things
 - We met with our team leaders and support staff and the following items were recommended for purchase:
 - Coach Books for LAFS
 - Sciencosauris Books to help with instruction since we

- no longer have science textbooks
 - Listening centers for primary grades
 - Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI) kits for intervention groups
 - Laptop Computers –
 - SAC approved that our accountability funds be used to purchase the items above – instructional materials and technology listed above.
 - We also discussed our Title III ESOL funds that were allocated to our school. Our total is \$4,000 and we are in the process of creating an order for additional materials to support our ESOL and Dual Language students.
- VI. Title I – Family and Community Engagement
- Shared resources for workshops, trainings, and other learning opportunities for families.
 - Shared website to access the course catalog.
- VII. Other school related business
- Shared Mr. Ficara’s minutes regarding the South Area Advisory Council Meeting on November 14, 2018
 - Discussed Stop the Bleed training that all staff participated in yesterday. Showed SAC team the kits that we received.
 - Mrs. Ramirez discussed sending out a ParentLink and Survey to see if parents would be interested in having a summer camp here at Lakeside.
 - Our next SAC meeting is scheduled for December 19th and the first SAC meeting of 2019 is scheduled for January 28th.
