Meeting commenced at 2:30 PM

- I. Roll Call
- II. Approval of September Minutes
 Minutes approved as written
- III. School Improvement Plan Update
 - Parents are encouraged and allowed to provide input.
 - Discussed different components of the SIP.
 - It is in the process of being evaluated and feedback will be provided.
 - We are continuing with rock and roll reading and providing all students in K-5 with targeted reading skills to most fragile students.
 - Our support staff and administration are providing interventions to students in grade 4 & 5.
 - Our specials teachers are providing enrichment activities to students performing on grade level based on state assessments.
 - We are also working on providing all of our students with differentiated math groups.

IV. Title 1 Plan

- Parents allowed to give input.
- We will be offering an FSA camp to our lowest quartile students in grade 4 math and grade 5 math/science for 9 weeks.
- Learning gains are calculated by the state in both reading and math.
- Funds can only be used to help with student achievement.
- Family Literacy night is coming up on November 13.
- Technology night information will also be forthcoming scheduled for Wednesday, December 5th.
- Funds are also available through Title 1 for parent involvement.

V. Social Emotional Learning Plan

- We are in the process of having the plan approved
- Discussed the 3 goals of the plan below and shared examples of each goal:
 - 1. Self-Awareness/Self-Management
 - 2. Social Awareness, Interpersonal Skills, Positive Relationship
 - 3. Decision Making and Responsible Behaviors

VI. South Area Advisory Council Minutes

Reviewed minutes shared by Mr. Ficara from October 24 meeting.

- Discussed concerns regarding students misplacing/losing their school ID's.
- We recently contacted our photographer to see if they can get us an ID Printing Machine so we can print our own school ID's.
- We are waiting to hear more information regarding how we will manage this concern.
- Safety concerns were also discussed regarding fence/gate and staffing concerns regarding manning the gate.
- Mrs. May shared that an independent company was hired to walk our school property and make safety recommendations.
- One of the things that was recommended was extra video cameras.
- District shared that since every school is unique, our SAC committees would be responsible for making recommendations.
- Mrs. May shared that we also had a traffic study done to look at our traffic patterns.

VII. Flanigan High School Mentors/Tutors

- Urban Teacher Academy Program shared information about our primary students receiving support in their classrooms to help build their literacy skills from our UTAP high school students.
- Latinos in Action Program shared information about our 4th and 5th grade students receiving support during lunch to help building their literacy skills.

VIII. A+ Vote

- We heard that the A+ funds may be in and our school is working on sharing disbursement date with staff.

IV. Other school related business

- Free/reduced lunch applications Mrs. May will be sending out a parent link to remind parents to apply if they have not already.
- We will be taking the Broward Standards Assessment (BSA) in January to help us see where our students are.
- Florida Standard Assessment (FSA) will be paper based next school year.
- We are inviting our active military and veterans to come enjoy lunch at our school on Friday, November 9th. Notices will be sent home shortly.
- Our school currently has approximately \$11,201.96 in accountability funds. We would like our SAC to begin thinking about how we would like to spend this money. Mrs. Sanchez suggested providing our Dual Language classes with literacy materials in Spanish. Mrs. Martinez suggested trying Reflex Math (math fluency program) free for one month and requested a quote from the company.
- Mr. Tom asked about the upcoming midterm election and recommendations regarding property tax vote.
- Next SAC Meeting is Wednesday, November 28th.
