Falcon Cove Middle School, School Advisory Council (SAC) Minutes: April 10th, 2019. A meeting of Falcon Cove SAC was held at FCMS in the Teachers' Lounge. David Malca called the meeting to order at 8:38 am

*Motion to approve the February minutes by Mr. Bryant and seconded by Mrs. Velez

Mr. Malca: I will be attending a training to discuss next years SIP. We are looking for SAC members for next year.

Ms. Stringer: Thank you SAC for approving math tutoring this year. Program made a big impact this year. Math tutoring ran for 17 weeks. Initially 80 students attended from all grade levels including all math levels. Program trickled down to mainly level 1 and 2 math students. Students were tutored one on one by same tutors consistently by Mu Alpha Theta and National Honor Society. Many students came to do just homework due to block scheduling. Suggested to streamline tutoring next year to level 1 and 2 students next year. Possibly send letters home next year suggesting program to parents of level 1 and 2.

<u>Principal's Report by Dr, Kaplan:</u> Testing season is underway. State mandated paper-based testing for 6th graders this year. Testing schedule is concise this year to avoid kids being held in testing centers unnecessarily. Testing is later this year; however scores are still expected in the summer. Middle School eStore opened by Dave Roca for athletics. Budget for next year anticipated next week. Planning for next year with Mrs. Rubin. More students are requesting study hall for next year.

<u>Math Report by Ms. Kamay:</u> Math Competition Team is going to Chicago for the first time. More teachers are using Canvas which is very helpful. Due to Canvas grading, it is freeing up instruction time. FSA preparation continues.

<u>Science Report by Mrs. Velez:</u> 8th grade teachers working to prepare students for Science SSA and Biology EOC. Three potential winners for eCyber mission. Two teams from 8th grade and one team from 7th grade. Response on winners expected next week.

Foreign Language Report by Mr. Rodriguez: Foreign Language Competition went well. 8 students received 1st place, 5 students received 2nd place, 6 students received 3rd place, and 2 students received honorable mention. 170 students went to the Latinos in Action Conference at FIU. 260 students attended a picnic at Markham Park for Latinos in Action and Peer Counseling. Latinos in Action and Peer Counseling are collecting supplies for Venezuela.

Language Arts Report by Mrs. Reichow: Literacy Teachers working on FSA prep with students. Members of the literacy department attended an FSA strategies workshop. We learned about distractor questions FSA uses for ELA. Information learned was passed on to the department. 10 students from Falcon Cove will be awarded 1st, 2nd, or 3rd at Broward County Literary Fair. Parents are encouraged to visit FSA practice website.

<u>History/Social Studies Report by Mr. Bryant:</u> 7th grade teachers are working with students to prepare them for Civics EOC in May.

ESE/Gifted Report by Mr. Malca on behalf of Ms. Bandman: Gifted Academy at Plantation High. All Falcon Cove Gifted Students are eligible to attend. Visited Gator Run for incoming ESLS. May 9th parent info night at Falcon Cove for ESLS students


