Reports:

1. Principal's Report

- Exhibition Night is this evening!
- School enhancement \$100,000.00.

Determination of how funds are spent go through SAC. Options will go on 2 ballots and are presented to SAC prior to going out. Each teacher, parent and SAC member gets 1 vote. Voting will take place and SAC will approve. There is no set time frame to spend the money. We need to make decisions on what we want. Next we need to obtain a quote as close to \$100,000 and submit to the district. We can't use the money on subscriptions or outside awnings. Up to \$85,000.00 can be for 1 project and the balance to another. Ideas: new camera equipment for morning announcements, video and buzzer system, new playground, technology updates, school improvement, classroom libraries, picnic tables outside, new upgrades on student laptops, etc... The project we decide on must have at least a 5 year warranty.

- our single point of entry is complete. We passed inspection. Our exterior bike rack is open and interior is closed. Students and teachers are still getting used to the new entry way, how to exit and enter.
