- 1. Principal's Report
 - -current enrollment is 872. Budget projections for next year is 864.
 - -Title 1 numbers have dropped. There will be a \$5-6,000.00 decrease in Title 1 money for next year
 - -School enhancement \$100,000.00. We are continuing to gather ideas and obtain quotes. Ideas: new camera equipment for morning announcements, video and buzzer system, new playground, technology updates, school improvement, classroom libraries, picnic tables outside, new upgrades on student laptops, etc... We will complete the projects in the upcoming school year.
 - There will be a Multi-Cultural Art Exhibit on May 16, 2019 from 6-8pm. We will also do Tile Painting for our legacy wall and the book fair. It is a celebration of the arts!

- 2. Title One Report -Mrs. Polacek presented.
