- Security and Safety- New Norm in District- Staff member will sit outside the main office to monitor entrance
- Campus Monitor will be added to our school in the near future.
- Doors will always remain locked for safety.
- They are currently doing perimeter check daily.
- The 300 building is to be locked at all times but playground is open and available.
- All staff and students will be expected to wear i.d. badges daily.
- If parents are going to have early dismissal the office has requested that you call ahead.
- No student will be release without I.D shown in the front office.
- Our practice code red drill and went well.
- We want parents to check voicemail before calling the school because it's usually the parent link.
- In the future there may just be a possible email and text to alert parents because parents are calling on drill days to check missed calls.
- Students will be aware, so they know ahead of time if we are having practice drills.
- Online forms are electronic this year all you need is your child's student number.
- Next Tuesday, will be a voting day. Our district has put a referendum to add security officers, pay increase salaries to high quality teachers, offer raises to non-instructional staff. This is a strong referendum for if not passed a lot of Broward teachers may leave to better paying counties.
