#### BUDGET

- -Mrs. Hall shared the 2019 projection report at the meeting and reviewed it. The number total is our projection for the upcoming school year. Currently we are at 847.89, however, 5th grade students leave and Kindergarten students come in. Numbers will be change and we will most likely have more students than projected. IDEA funding= \$81,505 Part B unique Aides, Part B Autism = \$213,097.
- -Special Revenue: Parent Involvement Allocation (Tittle 1) budget: School Allocation= \$238,545 and Parent Involvement = \$3,724. Supplemental Activities= \$26,505.00 I-Ready, Staff development training, consulting.
- -Currently we have a team here working on air quality within the schools.
