New Business:

Last month's meeting was called in order to come up with percentages for the staff to vote on for the distribution of the A+ funds. The ballot included the following three options:

Choice 1

_____ 80% of monies will be given to instructional staff and 20% will be given to non-instructional staff for those employed during the 2017-18 school year only (with the exception of those who were probationary, released, terminated, or resigned). All staff members who were employed at least 50% of the year will receive 50% of eligible benefits.

Choice 2

_____ 60% of monies will be given to instructional staff and 40% will be given to non-instructional staff for those employed during the 2017-18 school year only (with the exception of those who were probationary, released, terminated, or resigned). All staff members who were employed at least 50% of the year will receive 50% of eligible benefits.

Choice 3

_____ None of the Above

The Staff received a final written A+ Recognition proposal voting ballot via email on Thursday December 13, 2018. The voting date was scheduled for Wednesday December 19, 2018 at 8:45am at Charles Drew Family Resource Center and at 2pm at Dave Thomas Education Center.

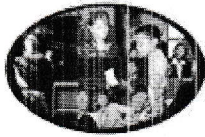
