2. Introduction. Introductions of members and guests.
3. Approval of Minutes—Motion to Approve by Ms. Moas and seconded by Ms. Wilson
4. LAFS/MAFS—These are replacing the BSA (Broward School Assessment). The prior years' data differed from the FSA results, so wanted to try something different.
 - a. This diagnostic portion is a test by iReady.
 - b. The 5th grade is using iReady for everything (in school and homework), but K-4 cannot use iReady because we are only paying for it for 5th grade.
 - c. However, all grades can use the diagnostic tests, so we are using that for all grades instead of BSA.
 - d. This will give us an item analysis that will help decide how to teach for the next few months.
 - e. We will have the analysis back before the BSA is actually given
5. Smart Bond Update—The playground is moving along. We needed to spend \$1,500 to put in a fence to divide the kindergarten from the second grade section. The next phase is for our plan to go before the board and secure the funding. The replacement of the roof and the chiller unit in Building 4 is in the next phase. The roof will likely start next summer and the chiller unit will start next winter.
