 - (1) The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) was signed into law in December 2015, amending the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 and replacing No Child Left Behind provisions.
 - (2) You can see the status of all our schools and what the ratings are. This will be the base line. The state and federal government will be looking at schools that continuously receive an A or B grade but have sub-groups not showing gains. The District will come up with a plan to help schools with those sub-groups. A new list will come out in July 2019. Presently, the ELL students and students with disabilities are the two groups not showing much gains in BCPS.
