



Sunset Lakes Elementary School SAC Meeting 4/24/2019

1. Call to order: Meeting started at 5:42 pm.
2. Welcome and Minutes Approval. Ms. Hudson welcomed everyone and asked for a review and approval of the minutes from March. Motion to Approve by Ms. Wilson, seconded by Ms. Squire. Voice Vote approval.
3. Equity Plan: Ms. Hudson is the equity liaison for SLE the County Equity Plan. This is a process to ensure that all children have equal access to education.
 - a. Behavior Issues, FSA Scores are both being looked at in relation to SLE. Ms. Hudson.
4. FSA Prep: Next week's testing starts with 4th and 5th grade and then 3rd grade is added in at the end of the week. The kids and teachers seem very ready and Mr. C. is optimistic that SLE kids are going to do great this year.
5. School Recognition Funds-BrainPop
 - a. This is the A+ money that comes from FSA funds SLE receives based on FSA scores .
 - b. Mr. C. would like to purchase BrainPop with the A+ money. There is currently \$4,321.26 in the account. \$2,550.00 is the cost for BrainPop for next year. There will be \$1,771.26 in the account, which will carry over to next year.
 - i. BrainPop is a computer learning program that is geared for Grades 3-5 and BrainPop Jr. is for K-2. The topics (language arts, math, social studies) are covered in videos and then kids answer questions that relate to the videos. There are also activities including movie making and graphic organizers that can be used in class.
 - ii. BrainPop is also available on SSO and can be used at home.
 - c. Motion to Approve by Ms. Harran; seconded by Ms. Guitar. Voice Vote approved unanimously.
6. Accountability Funds –Coach Digital
 - a. This funding comes from the State and is based on enrollment. There is \$6708.00 in the account right now. Mr. Charpentier would like to spend \$6,499.00 for “Coach Digital”. The remaining funds will carry forward to next year.
 - b. This computer product is used in Grades 3-5. This has all the standards for math, reading and science incorporated into it. There is a lot of FSA practice, sample assessments that teachers can use and it follows the FSA standards very closely, so it is valuable for the teachers.
 - c. Motion to approve by Ms. Harran and seconded by Ms. Wilson. Voice Vote approved unanimously.
7. Discussion of Transportation. There have been some issues this year with field trip buses. Administration has been working with BCPS Transportation directly to make sure it does not happen again.
8. Update on Playground—The playground opening is waiting on the issuance of the COI.
9. Next Meeting. Next SAAC meeting is 5/22/2019 and all are welcome to attend.
