A motion to approve the minutes for November 13th meeting was made. The minutes were confirmed by Ms. Overstreet and Mrs. Rumble-Wise.

Principal's Corner

Mrs. Priester Reviewed data for Rocket Academy, I-Ready, and Interim Assessments. According to the data the students meeting the projected goal. Mrs. Priester discussed the changes in instructions in preparation of FSA testing. The Dillard Innovation Zone Showcase will be hosted at William Dandy Middle School on January 17, 2019.
