

School Advisory Council (SAC) Meeting Minutes - Tuesday, February 19, 2019 Location: Room 135 ~ Time: 3:15 P.M.

- I. Welcome Mrs. Nurrito called the meeting to order at 3:21 P.M.
- II. Previous Meeting Minutes Ms. Weber shared copies of the minutes from the previous meeting.
 Ms. Ojeda motioned to approve. Ms. Robuste seconded.
- Principals Update Mr. Levine welcomed the members in attendance and thanked them for being 111. part of SAC. We recently recognized the Douglas Tragedy by planting gardens around the school by Mrs. Miller's Class and the Autism Cluster. Last Thursday and Friday we were on Code Yellow as a precaution. Several Margate officers were on campus that day to support our school. We are continuing to do our monthly lockdown drills. Drills at the beginning of the year were announced. Since January our drills have been unannounced, teachers only know the week that they will be happening. This month's lockdown will take place during lunch. March will be a silent lockdown drill which will not be announced on the P.A. system. All of these things are to challenge our staff and students to make sure that we are prepared. The district is working to hire outside agencies to visit every school to check and see how safety can be increased. Liberty is in a better spot then some schools because we have two buildings and we are a newer school. Some district policies are in draft form and soon to be passed: Hard Corner, Safer Spaces – more information on this program is forthcoming; Emergency Drills – we are working to raise the bar with our current drills, it is emphasizing that all members must participate in the drill (cafeteria, custodial, etc.), expands the policy for having locked classroom doors, and for all staff to understand that if any staff member sees something suspicious they can call 911 and initiate a code red; the district is raising the bar for threat assessments - social media and the internet are leading young students to feel invisible and feel they can post threats without it being held responsible for their posts. We are looking into obtaining presenters for parents regarding social media for students.
 - a. SAC Accountability Budget We find ourselves in very difficult times for budgets. We have been working diligently throughout the year to use funds to obtain supplies and materials for students to use for intervention. We have approximately \$2000 remaining in our SAC budget. There is a request for laminating paper for \$402.50, money to fix two teacher projectors


