

School Advisory Council (SAC) Meeting Minutes - Tuesday, March 19, 2019 Location: Room 135 ~ Time: 7:40 A.M.


- 1. Welcome Mrs. Nurrito called the meeting to order at 7:44 A.M.
- II. Previous Meeting Minutes Ms. Weber shared copies of the minutes from the previous meeting.
 Mrs. Nurrito motioned to approve. Ms. Ojeda seconded.
- III. SAC Accountability Funds Update Mr. Levine shared an update regarding the SAC accountability budget. We need to be more specific with the programs being purchased. Fundations and Bilingual picture books are the items that will be purchased for our ELL students using the SAC accountability funds (\$1190) that were allocated in the previous meeting minutes. Mr. Levine shared that there is more money available and shared that teachers are still in need of toner and kindergarten teachers need printers, their team only has one printer. The members in attendance agreed to use the remaining funds to purchase the needed printer(s) and toner(s). Ms. Weber motioned to approve and Ms. Ojeda seconded.
- IV. Principal's Update Mr. Levine shared some safety updates with the members in attendance. The gates are now being locked for longer times as an added safety measure. The posted signs will be updated to reflect the new times. We have recently hired a new PE teacher, David Ocasio, has started and is an experienced PE teacher in Puerto Rico and Florida. The new district policies regarding emergency codes have more clearly outlined the procedures that need to be in place for the emergency drills. The district also created a new department called the Department of Safety and Security heading by David Katz. The district passed a policy on threat assessments. School administrators and mental health counselors are obligated to investigate any threat assessments. Safer Spaces is a new policy in which schools are expected to identify safe spaces for students to go in the event of a threat or active shooter. The district will be rolling out a plan on how to identify safer spaces at each school. We had an unannounced safety drill yesterday that was communicated to staff not using the PA system. We are trying many different scenarios in order to make sure that our staff and students are prepared. FSA starts after spring break. Mr. Levine, Ms. Styles, and the SRO's did presentation

V. Internet Safety Presentation – Officer Hernandez and Officer Harrison, or school SRO's, made a presentation to the members in attendance regarding internet safety. This presentation was made to our grade 3-5 students in conjunction with Mr. Levine and Ms. Styles. The officers recommended to monitor what your children are doing on social media and the internet when they are using it at home.

Members in attendance were invited to suggest verbiage that should be added or deleted when creating the 2019-2020 Title I Plan and to bring the suggestions to the next meeting. The parental involvement fund amount fluctuates each year. Last year we spend the money for FSA night for teacher presenters, money for refreshments for parent training, student agendas for teacher-parent-student communications, folders for kindergarten students, and parent registration for Title I Events. The parent engagement plan was discussed, and we had approximately 1,166 parents signed in to all of the events that we had last year. Our goal is to increase that amount by 10% the following years. Ms Styles in inviting members in attendance to participate in the School Improvement Plan Online Survey for all stakeholders. Flyers with the web address were passed out to members in attendance.


