6b) Principal Updates

Mrs. DeVaughn give us some updates about the school:

- The school will get bullet proof glass very soon (starting Oct 5th 2018), starting with two class room doors and the front door, which is all glass. Each door cost approx \$250. There are discussion going on to do a fundraiser, maybe together with the PTA
- Sandy Hook Project --> start with HELLO began last week. This is under the umbrella of emotional safety. It is to help indentify if a child may be sad, has some issues or may be otherwise emotionally not at 100%.
- Gate Safety. Some have observed that a parent just walked into the school even a person asked to stop. The parent has been identified and Officer Mark will speak with that person.
- Street crossing: Some parents noted there could be a safety issue with kids crossing the streets or sometimes running across the street to get to their parents car. Mrs. DeVaughn will address this issue.

7+8) Updates from the CENTRAL AREA ADVISORY General Meeting from Aug 30 and Sept 13, 2018

Steve Barrow, CAAC chair, and our special guest of today, informs us about the CAAC meeting:

- Security remains a big issue, in all the schools
- The biggest issues however are outside of the schools
- Steve will bring this to the school board that they need to put more weight into this issue, maybe have special person appointed on the school board that is only in charge of security + safety
- Parents have the strongest voice, not only in this subject, in general let's make sure parents are involved it make the biggest difference.

We also discussed, that it is not only about meeting the district's security requirements, parents need to be better educated in general about security, what works and what does not work. Need some trust in the experts of security.
