- ❖ Establish quorum
- ❖ New Business
 - SBBC Policy 1403 & 1403-A – Mrs. Brissett
 - Purpose of SAC – The School Advisory Council (SAC) facilitates the development of and monitor the progress of the annual School Improvement Plan (SIP)
 - SAC/SAF/SIP -SAC is focused on School Improvement Plan (SIP)
 - School Advisory Forum (SAF) can discuss school issues to bring recommendations, concerns, and interests to our North Area Advisory meetings.
 - Linda Mills has agreed to attend North Area Advisory meetings.
 - Important dates - Upcoming deadlines:
 - 10/18 Completion of SIP.
 - 10/25 SAC Composition Report
 - 11/15 Complete the Intent to Apply for new waiver for Professional Study Days (PSD).
 - 2/8 Deadline to apply for new Professional Study Day (PSD) waiver.
 - New Waivers
 - Schools must apply for a new PSD waiver every five years in order to be eligible to have Professional Study Days
 - Coral Glades must apply for a new waiver this year in order to continue with PSDs for the next five years.
 - A+ Recognition Fund – If we are eligible due to moving from a school grade of C to a B, all decisions and votes must be completed and submitted by 2/1/2019.
 - SAC Composition Report – the SAC must represent the demographics from the school. If the SAC is not in compliance, the SAC will not be allowed to conduct votes and will miss out on school improvement funds.
 - Please invite additional students and parents to join the SAC.
 - Mrs. Brissett asked everyone in attendance to turn in SAC Member Information Sheets
 - SAC Composition – Next meeting will include a vote by each stakeholder group to approve new SAC members of the same stakeholder group.
 - SAC Bylaws – 18 voted to approve and keep the same, 0 voted against.
 - SIP Update – School grade went up to a B last school year. The SIP includes several other plans within it. Mrs. Kelley Fisher and Dr. Paul Satty will be invited to the October meeting to discuss the RtI process.
- ❖ Old Business
- ❖ PTSO Update – Linda Mills spoke. PTSO now offers online payments. They also have a page on the Coral Glades website that is kept updated.
 - Upcoming event – Score at the Top is offering an SAT review beginning 10/3/2018.

- ❖ Principal's Update – Mr. Carruth – Welcome back to everyone.
 - Introduce School Resources Officers - Officer Bonasera and Officer Burton
 - Update on safety and security – replace former campus monitor at 11 am – 7 pm.
 - 90.3% of classes meet class size, so we did meet the class size mandate. Will use additional funds for an additional campus monitor position.
 - The IDs process is going quite smoothly.
 - Our school grade improved more than any other traditional high school in Broward County, despite the many challenges of the 2017-18 school year.
 - Continuing with school improvement, the literacy department is focused on PSAT and SAT. All students in grades 9, 10, and 11 will take the PSAT on October 10th, 2018. The district is still planning to pay for all 11th graders to take the SAT on a school day later on in the school year.
 - All students should be using Khan Academy. It's a free program that is personalized to help students improve their test scores. FSA retakes are in progress and there will be another opportunity in December.
 - Victor asked Mr. Carruth what the purpose is for tardy center. Mr. Carruth answered that students should be on campus on time and it's a way to make sure that all students head to class in a timely manner.
 - Victor also suggested that the tardy center should be moved closer to the front of the school. Mr. Carruth replied that the admin team had considered it before and could look into it again. The cafeteria can be far from the front, but it is central for students coming from student parking and the parent drop-off in teacher parking. The easiest way to avoid it is being on time. The process is sped up with the ID scanning.
 - Chelsea asked if the district pays for an ACT test day like SAT. Mr. Carruth replied that the district has never paid for ACT. Coral Glades is a testing site for the Saturday ACTs. Fee waivers are available for eligible students. Mrs. Brissett gave the upcoming ACT dates. Ms. Karissa Sutton gave information about the fees for ACT tests.
 - Jose asked about the rumors of a C lunch being started. Mr. Carruth responded that there is no validity to the rumors. Our enrollment hasn't changed enough to even consider it.
 - Ms. Bernstein asked if 9th and 10th graders can take the ACT. Mrs. Brissett and Mr. Carruth responded that there is no age limit on SAT or ACT.
