School Recognition Funds

Ms. deVarona explained the use of School Recognition Funds ("A+" funds) due to the school's "A" rating based on 2017-2018 FSA Scores. SAC members will create a draft proposal of three options to present to staff to vote on.

Option 1:

- All full-time Discovery Elementary employees including pool substitutes from the 2017-2018 school year who started by 10/9/17 and completed the 2017-2018 school year will equally share 85% of the School Recognition Funds.
- All part-time Discovery Elementary Employees from 2017-2018 school year who started by 10/9/17 and completed the 2017-2018 school year will receive \$450 of the School Recognition Funds.
- 15% of the funds will be earmarked for Saturday Enrichment Camp and Student Celebration.

Option 2:

- All full time and part-time Discovery Elementary employees including pool substitutes from the 2017-2018 school year who started by 10/9/17 and completed the 2017-2018 school year will equally share 85% of the School Recognition Funds.
- 15% of the funds will be earmarked for Saturday Enrichment Camp and Student Celebration.
