

## SAC Minutes 8/27/18

- I. Gloria Arencibia called the meeting to order at 5:33 PM. Went around the room and introductions were made for all attendees.
- II. Department Reports are explained to the floor. Ms. Rivas presented about the Social Studies Department (refer to the PowerPoint attached). Visions is completely project based to help with junior year EOC (US History). Ms. Houston stated that 65 students are enrolled in the new elective available. Ms. Rivas explains that students enrolled in the BVS Government class had a 100% pass rate. Ms. Houston explain that her club takes the school as a whole and makes sure all groups are being serviced. In February, there will be an African history and black history expo. To raise money for this expo the club will be hosting a car wash at the same time as the VET dog wash. In the month of February this club will be hosting multiple events such as representatives from HBC (Historically Black Colleges and Universities) interview and give scholarships on the spot. Ms. Rivas stated the missing scores from the state of Florida and the district.

- VII. Ms. Pena explained how to sign up for the SAC remind 101.
- VIII. New Business- Ms. Yard stated that Homecoming week will be October 8-13, 13<sup>th</sup> dance and 12<sup>th</sup> is the football game SGA September 25 and each week it goes up \$10. Ms. Mola explained that October 10<sup>th</sup> is the PSAT testing day. Mr. Fatout stated that 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade tests are free and juniors can sign up and pay online. Ms. Mola also explained that morning announcements link is posted on the school website and the back to school/code of conduct forms are available online.
- IX. Mrs. Engeler asked if juniors registered to take the SAT should sign up for the PSAT. Ms. Liverpool explained to that she encourages all students to take the PSAT for national

merit status opportunity. The PSAT also gives a report to the student on how to improve their scores in their areas of growth. Students can also use this report with the help of Khan Academy to specifically target those areas of potential growth. Ms. Mola explained that all students across the country take the PSAT on the same day.

- X. Ms. Arencibia explains that open house is on September 4<sup>th</sup>. Ms. Aleman stated that PTSA will have their first meeting in the media center on September 13<sup>th</sup>. Newsletter was shown on the school website for other school announcements.
