Ms. Naylor and Ms. Bravo suggested surveying the stakeholders. Ms. Beasley offered to help in this area.

Surveys may help measure the implementation of the goals.

Ms. Bravo revisited customer service as a priority.

Ms. Beasley added customer service is key for public schools, especially with charter school competition.

Ms. Newmeyer stated customer service training should be presented to all staff at the schools.

Ms. Fertig recommended promoting the school (the positives) rather than fighting against charter schools. She suggested using one session at the Secondary School Forum for this topic.

Ms. Johnson said parents want to feel welcomed and included, and they want their children to be safe – those are the priorities.

Ms. Fertig distributed previous forum packets, including the agenda format, discussion questions and group rules.

Mr. Naylor recommended combining high school and middle school parents in each group – a great learning experience.
