Step 1: Three resources to draw Broward School Board single-member district maps:

Step 2	Step 2: From March to June 28 th at 5:00 p.m. the Redistricting Steering Committee members and the public may schedule a two hour public meeting where District staff will draw your district map alternative(s). In addition, one public workshop will be held in each administrative area to provide assistance to community members who wish to participate in drawing single school board member maps. District map alternatives should have no more or less than 5% above or below the 2010 U.S. Census Broward County population average.
Step 3	Step 3: All maps submitted through Step 2 must be completed and submitted two weeks prior to the week of the next public hearing. The final day to submit a completed map will be Wednesday, July 11 th at 5:00 p.m. Maps and supporting data will be emailed with the agenda to all Redistricting Steering Committee members and will be published on the School Board Redistricting Web site one week prior to the next scheduled Redistricting Steering Committee public hearing.
Step 4	Step 4: During any one of the Redistricting Steering Committee public hearing • Map creators are allowed 5 minutes to present their map option(s). • 2 minutes maximum are given to each person wishing to comment on a map option(s).
Step 5	Step 5: Upon completion of the seven district public hearings held throughout the county, the School Board appointed Redistricting Steering Committee will make a final recommendation(s) to the School Board.
