- From 2005-06 to 2007-08 Broward County registered a **19% increase in the number of students enrolled in AP classes** (10,582 to 12,644) and a **22% increase in the number of AP examinations administered** (16,943 to 20,612).
- While the number of AP examinations with scores of 3 or above has increased 26 percentage points from 7,769 in 2005-06 to 9,818 in 2007-08, the percent of AP examinations scoring 3 or above has increased slightly (45.9% vs. 47.6%) during this three-year period.
- The percent of AP examination scores of 3 or above declined during this three-year period Globally and for Florida, but increased for Broward.
- **Black, Hispanic, and White students demonstrated gains in the number of AP participants.** However, the average number of AP examinations for each student declined for Black students from 1.58 in 2005-06 to 1.47 in 2007-08. The decrease in the average number of examinations for Black students is not unexpected, considering the large increase in the number of Black students participating, who may be opting to take a single AP course. The average number of AP examinations remained relatively stable for Hispanic and White students.

Research Brief

ADVANCED PLACEMENT PROGRAM ENROLLMENT AND RESULTS, 2005-06 THROUGH 2007-08

In keeping with Broward County Public Schools' (BCPS) Strategic Plan objective: *To increase the proportion of students Districtwide and by subgroup who successfully complete high rigor academic programs*, a review of the data for the past three school years demonstrated that the number of students enrolled in Advanced Placement (AP) courses increased dramatically during the time period examined. This increase was evident for the overall BCPS high school population, as well as for each student subgroup identified by race/ethnicity.

The present report reviews the latest data concerning student performance on the AP examinations. As the data show, the number of students taking AP examinations has risen in a complementary manner to the increase in AP course enrollment. Even with the increased number of students participating in the AP program, average scores were in line with students statewide and remained at a high level of performance during the most recently reported school year, 2007-08. Data concerning course offerings at each high school, including charter schools, were also examined; these data revealed that 100% of BCPS high schools with 9th through 12th grade enrollments offer students access to the full complement of six core AP courses through on-site offerings or via distance learning opportunities. Furthermore, the majority of high schools provide AP course offerings that extend well beyond the six core AP curriculum courses, with 33 (97%) of the high schools offering ten or more AP courses and one high school (Cypress Bay) offering 29 AP courses.

Background

The AP program is a College Board nationally recognized successful strategy for introducing students to the challenges of college-level coursework, while they are still in high school. The AP program:

- is structured so that high schools can offer college-level work in up to 38 courses covering 20 examination areas,
- provides an opportunity for students enrolled in AP courses and others who have completed related honors courses or studied independently to be tested on a level similar to college course standards, and
- provides voluntary staff development for AP teachers through consultants, workshops, and publications by College Board staff.

Advanced Placement examinations are scored on a scale ranging from one to five (1: no recommendation, 2: possibly qualified, 3: qualified, 4: well qualified, and 5: extremely

well qualified). Higher education institutions worldwide award college credit or advanced placement to students for AP coursework, with each college or university deciding which AP examination scores and courses will be accepted. Most higher education institutions grant credit and/or advanced placement for AP scores of 3 or better. Therefore, the standard for competency has been defined as a score of 3 or above (College Board, 2008).

BCPS students enrolled in AP courses are required under School Board Policy 6000.1 to participate in the AP examination (SBBC, 2008). Students who believe they will be successful on the AP examinations based on participation in other rigorous academic curriculum, such as International Baccalaureate (IB) classes, may sit for the examination(s) even though they are not enrolled in AP courses. Examination dates are determined by the College Board and are scheduled in May.

Funding

The BCPS District covers the cost of the AP examination for students enrolled in AP or IB courses. The College Board allows a fee reduction of \$22 for every test of students who qualify for free or reduced-price lunch services. Currently, home education students, private school students, and students not enrolled in an AP class or IB class are individually responsible for the cost of the AP assessments in which they participate.

District cost for the examinations during the 2007-08 school year was \$1,441,797. The Florida Department of Education (FDOE) provides school district funding for the AP Program through an annual allocation based on test performance. Each AP examination that is scored a 3 or above generates 0.16 FTE for every student (\$653.21 for each score of 3 or higher on examinations passed in the 2007-08 school year). A preliminary budget analysis indicates that the District will receive approximately \$6,323,707 in 2008-09 in AP funding for the examinations passed with a score of 3 or higher.

The AP funding received will be distributed to individual schools based on the number of tests scored 3 or above by students attending that school. The allocation may be used for purposes of increasing student achievement in AP coursework by such methods as increasing access to AP prerequisite courses and distance learning programs, as well as by providing staff development opportunities for participating teachers.

Method

District data were acquired from an electronic data file provided by the College Board and merged into the District's Data Warehouse by the District's Education Technology Services (ETS). However, Student demographic information on the College Board reports was self-reported by the students and therefore prone to error. The data analysis and summary methods were modified to increase the accuracy of reporting and aggregation for the various subgroups. The Broward County data summarized herein were extracted from the District's Data Warehouse after AP scores were linked with demographic and enrollment records. Results in this report include available data for every student enrolled in AP courses regardless of the number of courses taken by the student(s). AP examination participation and performance data at the state and global levels are reported in the *College Board AP Distribution Report*.

Findings

Global, Florida, and Broward

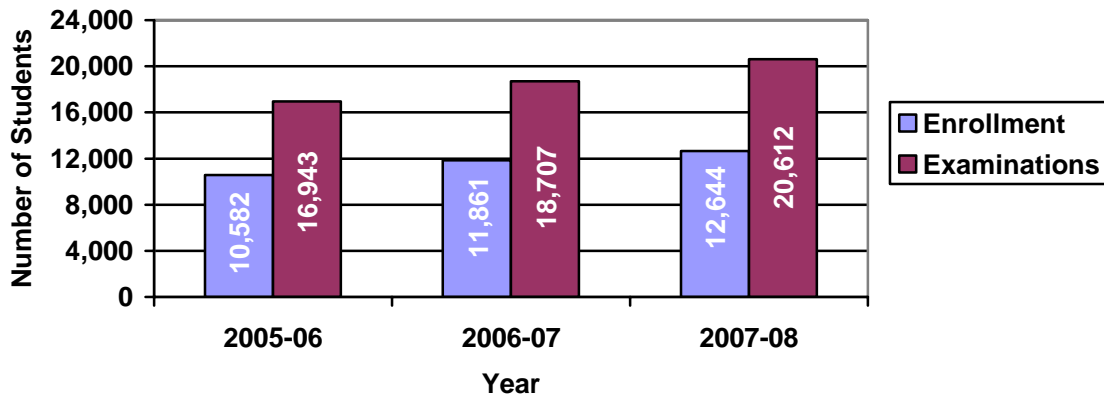


Figure 1. Number of students enrolled in AP classes and the number of AP examinations administered in Broward County, 2005-06 through 2007-08.

AP Enrollment and Number of Examinations Administered. Table 1 provides the number of students enrolled in AP courses and the number of AP examinations administered across the Globe, for Florida, and in Broward from 2005-06 through 2007-08. Figure 1 illustrates data for Broward students only. During the three-year period, Broward County posted a 19% increase in the number of students enrolled in AP classes (10,582 to 12,644) and a 22% increase in the number of AP examinations administered (16,943 to 20,612). In comparison, across the Globe, there was an 18% increase in the number of students enrolled and in the number of AP examinations administered. Statewide, there was a 28% increase in enrollment and a 27% increase in the number of AP examinations administered.

Table 2 reports the total high school 20th day enrollment (SBBC, 2008), AP enrollment (students enrolled in at least one AP course), the percent of high school students taking at least one AP examination, and the number of AP examinations administered. As seen in the table, even though the high school enrollment declined (from 73,651 in 2005-06 to 71,378 in 2007-08) a positive trendline is noted in the number of students enrolled in at least one AP course, in the percent of AP enrollment, and in the number of AP examinations administered over the same three-year period.

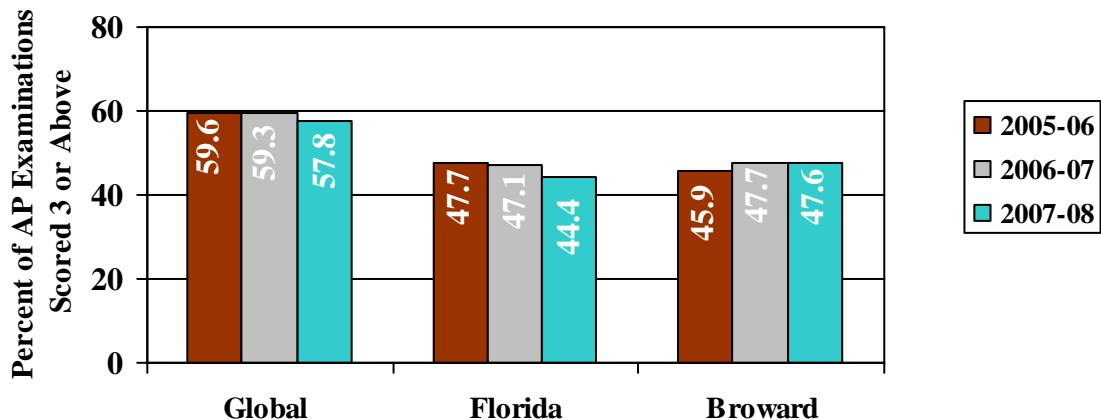


Figure 2. Percent of AP examinations 3 or above in Broward, compared to Global and Florida results, 2005-06 through 2007-08.

Table 3 provides a comparison of mean AP examination scores, the number of AP scores 3 or above, and the percent of AP scores 3 or above for Global, Florida, and Broward participants from 2005-06 through 2007-08. While the number of AP examinations with scores of 3 or above has increased, the percent of AP examination scores of 3 or above has declined during this three-year period Globally and for Florida, but increased for Broward. Additionally, as presented in Table 3, a decrease in mean scores from the previous year is seen for Florida (2.52 to 2.44), while Broward scores remained stable (2.54 to 2.54). Globally, scores also declined from 2006-07 to 2007-08. In Broward, the percent of AP scores 3 or above increased from 2005-06 to 2006-07, and remained stable in 2007-08. Figure 2 provides a graphical depiction of the proportion of scores 3 or above for Global, Florida, and Broward.

Broward Performance by Ethnic Group

In general, Broward students continued to demonstrate success in the most rigorous of high school coursework, AP. However, the data indicate there are still gaps in the achievement of different ethnic groups. Recognizing that participation in API courses is an important mechanism for closing the gap, this report includes an analysis of AP scores by ethnicity.

Table 4 presents the number of students in each ethnic group participating in AP examinations. In addition, the table reports number of AP examinations by ethnicity, with the average number of examinations for each student. Although all ethnic categories as identified by the College Board are included in the table, the narrative below focuses only on the three categories of Black, Hispanic, and White, as these students represent the three groups that comprise 93.4% of all students in BCPS.

As indicated in Table 4, Black, Hispanic, and White students demonstrated increases in the number of AP participants. However, the average number of AP examinations for each student decreased for Black (1.58 to 1.47) students from 2005-06 through 2007-08. The average number of AP examinations remained relatively stable for Hispanic and White students.

Table 5 presents AP participation for Black, Hispanic, and White BCPS students from 2005-06 through 2007-08. As seen in the table, the number of Black students participating increased by 42 percent from 2005-06 to 2007-08, while the percent of students participating increased for Hispanic and White students by 27 and 17 percent, respectively. A decrease in the average number of examinations is noted for Black students over the three-year period from 1.58 to 1.47, while the average number of examinations for Hispanic students remained stable, and the average number of examinations for White students decreased slightly. The decrease in the average number of examinations for Black students is not unexpected considering the large increase in the number of Black students participating, who may be opting to take a single AP course.

AP examination performance. Table 6 presents average AP scores, number of AP scores 3 or above and percent of AP scores 3 or above by ethnicity for Broward over the past three years. As the number of students participating increased, it was expected that a decrease in mean scores would result. As displayed in Table 6, from 2005-06 through 2007-08, mean scores remained stable for Hispanic students, slightly declined for Black students (1.92 vs. 1.89), and increased for White students (2.58 vs. 2.66). All three groups posted increases in the number of AP examinations with scores of 3 or above; however, the percent of AP examinations with this performance remained stable for Black, and Hispanic students, with White students demonstrating improvement (49.2% vs. 52.9%).

Table 7 displays the percent of AP scores three or above for the three major ethnic groups from 2005-06 through 2007-08. The magnitude of the score differences has increased (3.3 points) between Black students and White students, and increased (3.7 points) between Hispanic and White students during the three reported school years.

Examination Area Results

Appendix A provides information by AP examination area from 2005-06 through 2007-08. Included are AP examination participation and summary data of examination scores registered at 3 or above. With the exception of Chinese Language & Culture, Japanese Language & Culture, and Latin Vergil, BCPS students participated in all other AP examination areas. Of the 34 AP examination areas taken by Broward students, the five taken by the greatest number of students in 2007-08 were: Psychology ($n=2,496$), United States History ($n=1,982$), English Language & Composition ($n=1,905$), Government & Politics: U.S. ($n=1,804$), and English Literature & Composition ($n=1,639$).

As reported in Appendix A, of the 30 examination areas with sufficient number of students participating to allow reporting of data, the number of AP examinations administered over the past three years has increased in 23 AP examination areas. Seven AP examination areas registered decreases in the number of AP examinations administered. Furthermore, the percent of students who earned a score of 3 or above increased in 17 examination areas but decreased in 13 examination areas. Increases in the number of AP examinations, the number scoring 3 or above, and the percent scoring 3 or above are noted in 11 AP examination areas (Art: Studio-Drawing Portfolio, Art: Studio 3-D Design, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Economics: Macroeconomics, Environmental Science, English Language & Composition, English Literature & Composition, Italian Language, Psychology, and World History).

Individual School Results

A review of the individual school aggregate results included in Appendix B revealed significant improvement from 2005-06 through 2007-08 at several schools when compared to Districtwide performance. As seen in Appendix B, of 34 Broward schools with three years of data, changes were noted from 2005-06 through 2007-08 as follows.

- Ten schools (Boyd Anderson, Cooper City, Coral Glades, Cypress Bay, Deerfield Beach, Everglades, Monarch, Pompano Beach Institute, Somerset Academy, and Stoneman Douglas) posted gains in the four AP categories, (number of AP students, number of AP examinations, number of AP scores 3 or above, and the percent of AP scores 3 or above).
- A decline in these four AP categories is noted at Blanche Ely and Hollywood Hills.

Appendix C provides passing rate information for each school. The appendix reports the number and percent of AP scores 3 or above, and the Global percent of AP scores 3 or above, disaggregated by examination area and overall. The percent of AP examinations at or above a score of 3 exceeded students globally by 20 percentage points or more in at least one examination area. Somerset Conservatory is not included since none of their AP-enrolled students participated in the examination. The AP examination areas in which specific schools outperformed the Global AP performance are as follows:

- Twelve examinations – Cypress Bay (Calculus AB, Chemistry, English Language & Composition, English Literature & Composition, European History, Government & Politics: U.S., Italian Language, Macroeconomics, Physics B, Spanish Language, Spanish Literature, and Statistics).
- Six examinations – Stoneman Douglas (Art: 2-D Design, English Language & Composition, Human Geography, Macroeconomics, Statistics, and World History).
- Five examinations each at two schools: Fort Lauderdale (Calculus AB, Chemistry, European History, Government & Politics: U.S., and U.S. History), and Nova (Art: Studio 2-D Design, Calculus AB, Human Geography, Spanish Literature, and World History).
- Four examinations at Northeast (Calculus AB, English Literature & Composition, Spanish Language, and U.S. History).
- Three examinations – J.P. Taravella (Calculus AB, Environmental Science, and Human Geography).
- Two examinations each at nine schools: Cooper City (English Literature & Composition, and Physics B), Coral Springs (English Language & Composition and Spanish Language), Dillard (Art: Studio 3-D Design and Music Theory), Everglades (Italian and Spanish Language), McArthur (Art: Studio 2-D Design and Calculus AB), Pembroke Pines Charter School (Spanish Language and World History), Pompano Beach Institute and South Broward (Calculus AB and Spanish Language), and South Plantation (Government & Politics: Comparative and Government & Politics: U.S.).
- One examination each at seven schools: Atlantic Technical (Psychology), Coral Glades (Calculus AB), Deerfield Beach (Statistics), Charles W. Flanagan and Miramar (Spanish Language), Monarch (Art: Studio 2-D Design), and Western (Human Geography).

As seen in Appendix C, 100% of AP scores 3 or higher are noted at Cypress Bay in four examination areas: Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Spanish Literature, and Statistics. In addition, 100% of AP scores 3 or above are noted in one examination at eight schools: Coral Glades and Pompano Beach Institute (Calculus BC), Dillard (Music Theory), Everglades (Italian Language), McArthur (Art: Studio 2-D Design), and at Miramar, Northeast, and South Broward (Spanish Language).

Actions Underway and Next Steps

BCPS District and school staff have implemented a range of actions in an effort to expand AP offerings, to increase student participation in AP courses, to assure equity of access to AP courses, and to increase student scores of 3 or above on those assessments. Several actions are noted below.

Ongoing Actions

- Entrance criteria to advanced courses have been established uniformly districtwide.
- A District “parent preference” form has been developed to allow parents to place their children in advanced coursework on a probationary basis.
- Parents of 8th and 9th grade students receive District developed correspondence explaining high school advanced academic options including AP, dual enrollment, and honors coursework. Parents are asked to encourage their children to visit with a guidance counselor for further information.
- Student Prediction Flags have been added to the Data Warehouse to identify students who may be ready for AP classes, as well as those who may be nearly ready and for whom extra assistance may prove to make the difference. School staffs review the prediction flags and encourage students to participate as appropriate. Access to Virtual Counselor by school personnel and parents aids in the identification of eligible students.
- All 10th grade students in Broward are required to take the PSAT. The pre-college entrance examinations are analyzed by the College Board. School reports are provided to identify those students who are deemed capable of succeeding in AP coursework, based on test results. The data are used for guidance and course selection activities.
- Broward has been a host site for several College Board workshops and through that effort has involved a greater number of local teachers and guidance counselors in these staff development activities.
- Master course schedules are reviewed to ensure the full complement of AP core courses is offered at each school site, including offerings through the distance learning program.
