SUBJECT: **DISTRICTWIDE SUMMARY OF INCIDENTS: 2004-05 THROUGH 2006-07**

The attached report details the types and prevalence of incidents reported in Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) during the 2004-05 through 2006-07 school years, as recorded in the District's Data Warehouse. In 2006-07, there were 9,718 reported incidents, corresponding to a rate of 37.0 incidents for every 1,000 students which represents an increase from the 7,840 incidents and rate of 28.9 in reported in 2005-06. The increase over last year is partially accounted for by the addition of Bullying/Harassment as a School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR) incident in 2006-07. Data Warehouse figures indicate that 2,380 (24.5%) of the SESIR incidents were coded as having been reported to law enforcement although the BCPS Special Investigative Unit received approximately 3,093 (31.8%) incident reports via submission of an Immediate Notification Form. This finding indicates a mismatch in reporting to law enforcement between what is indicated in the Total Educational Resource Management System (TERMS) and actual notification. Again this year, the percentage of incidents reported to law enforcement is low.

The attached report presents incident rates and patterns by school level, category of incident, and incident type. Data related to the primary characteristics of incidents, related elements, and incidents reported to law enforcement were also explored. As is true every year, the state warns against comparison across years and across districts as a result of state changes in the coding and definition of SESIR events and regional differences in interpretation. An Appendix provides a summary of incidents at each school, reflecting schools that reported a disproportionately high or low number of incidents. School staff should review these data to determine whether unusually high or low numbers of incidents may suggest erroneous data reporting. BCPS will use these incident data to identify schools in need of intervention due to high incident rates.

Districtwide Summary of Incidents: 2004-05 Through 2006-07

Executive Summary

Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) tracks any disciplinary incident that is against the law or represents a breach of the Student Code of Conduct and results in a consequence, such as suspension, alternative to suspension placement, or expulsion. The present report examines the frequency and types of incidents occurring at school, during school-sponsored activities, or on school-sponsored transportation from 2004-05 through 2006-07.

- In 2006-07, there were 9,718 reported incidents, corresponding to a rate of 37.0 incidents for every 1,000 students. This increase over the previous year is partially accounted for by the new inclusion of Bullying/Harassment as a *School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR)* system incident.
- The 2006-07 data indicate that there were increases in the incident rate at elementary, middle, and high schools and decreases at District centers.
- The most frequently reported incidents were categorized as Crimes Against Persons with the most commonly reported incident being Fighting.
- The proportions of incidents within a category (Crimes Against Persons, Other Offenses, Alcohol/Tobacco/Drug Offenses, and Property Offenses) remained relatively consistent across years.
- In 2006-07, as in previous years, the vast majority of incidents were committed by students (94.8%), on campus (98.1%), and during normal school hours (96.6%). Only 3.2% of all incidents reported were committed by unknown persons.
- Across all years, drug-related and weapon-related incidents occurred considerably more frequently than alcohol-related, gang-related, or hate-related incidents, although the total number of incidents flagged with *any* of these elements amounted to only nine percent of reported incidents. In 2006-07, a substantial reduction was observed in the reporting of both drug-related and weapon-related incidents. The number of alcohol-related and gang-related incidents remained small. Again, this year two hate-related incidents were reported.
- Only 3.6% of all incidents reported in 2006-07 involved weapons. As in previous years, knives accounted for more than 60% of all weapons, while less than one percent of weapon incidents involved any type of gun.
- Again in 2006-07, only a small portion of the total SESIR incidents were documented in the Total Educational Resource Management Systems (TERMS) as being reported to law enforcement (24.5%). To address this continuing problem, the District has developed a new Discipline Management System through a collaborative process that included staff based in the schools, Education Technology Services (ETS), Student Support Services, and Human Resource Development. As of October 1, 2007, the new Discipline Management System is being piloted in 25 District schools.

As is true every year, the state warns against comparisons across years and across districts as a result of state changes in the coding and definition of SESIR events and regional differences in interpretation. Broward County Public Schools will use these incident data to identify schools in need of intervention due to high incident rates.

Districtwide Summary of Incidents: 2004-05 Through 2006-07

Introduction

In 1995-96, the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) implemented a statewide system for reporting disciplinary incidents. The *School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting* (SESIR) system also allows for the reporting of pertinent incident-related elements, such as the type of offense, location of occurrence, and whether it was reported to law enforcement. One incident is reported for any single event, regardless of the number of individuals involved. Incidents occurring 24 hours a day, 365 days a year on school grounds, during school-sponsored activities, or on school-sponsored transportation are documented.

Only offenses that are violations of law or represent serious breaches of School Board Policy and/or the Student Code of Conduct are collected in the SESIR system and reported to the state. In addition to SESIR incidents, the District tracks all disciplinary incidents including those that are considered less serious “local” incidents. For example, the SESIR criterion for a reportable theft incident is \$300. Consequently, the theft of an item valued at or above \$300 is reported to the state as a SESIR incident, while the theft of an item of lesser value is recorded as a local incident.

In an ongoing effort to improve the quality of data collection and reporting, FDOE’s Office of Safe Schools routinely updates the Disciplinary Referral Actions and the SESIR definitions and related elements based on frequently asked questions, common reporting errors, and legislative mandates for the convenience of all school districts (FDOE, 2007). These changes to the Discipline Data Collection System make comparisons of data across school years problematic. In addition, the FDOE (2006a) notes that caution should be exercised in making comparisons of incident data across school districts due to the impact of a variety of social and environmental factors. A recent Washington Post article (de Vies, 2007) notes that, as a result of reporting difficulties, misinterpretation of data, and resultant bad press, few school systems in the United States regularly report student offenses to the public. Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) was highlighted as one of the few districts in the country that publishes incident data across more than 20 categories of offense for every school in the District every year.

Purpose of the Report

This report presents the frequency, types, and characteristics of incidents occurring within BCPS at school sites, school-sponsored activities, or on school-sponsored transportation for the years 2004-05, 2005-06, and 2006-07. Data are presented as number of occurrences and incident rates (i.e., the number of incidents for every 1,000 students). The data in this report are valuable to school staff members who utilize the school-level data to provide an overview of disciplinary events at their respective schools or for comparison to other schools. Area-level personnel examine data for schools in their respective areas to identify schools with significantly high or low incident rates. District-level personnel examine multi-year trends and school-level data to evaluate locations that have special programs or personnel in place to address discipline issues.

Methods

The FDOE changes to the SESIR system in 2006-07 include the addition of a Bullying/Harassment incident code, which increased the total number of SESIR reportable incident codes from 21 to 22. Bullying/Harassment is defined as “Unwanted and repeated written, verbal, or physical behavior, including any threatening, insulting, or dehumanizing act by an adult or student that is severe or pervasive enough to create an intimidating, hostile or offensive educational environment, cause discomfort or humiliation, or unreasonably interfere with the individual’s school performance or participation” (FDOE, 2006b, p. P-2). Prior to 2006-07, Bullying/Harassment was coded as a local incident. A “bullying-related” element code was also added to be used when another incident (e.g., fighting or battery) is bullying-related (FDOE, 2006c). Other changes for 2006-07 include the revision of expulsion codes to define different types of expulsions (with or without continuing educational services) as well as minor changes to definitions related to weapons, alcohol, drug, and “disruption on campus” incidents (FDOE, 2006d).

- Incident data were retrieved from the District’s Data Warehouse on September 26, 2007. Data for each school year reflect incidents occurring between August 1, 2006, and July 31, 2007. These dates closely correspond to Survey 5 dates that delineate the start and end dates of the school year.
- Local incidents were filtered from the data set so that only SESIR incidents are included in the present report.
- The incident rate was calculated based on the District’s 2006-07 20th day enrollment (The School Board of Broward County, 2006a). Incident rates by school level were calculated using data from an additional master file from which the District’s published 20th day data were calculated. The master file was obtained from the School Boundaries Department.
- Multiple incidents that were reported on a single day, at a single school, at the identical time which were also an identical match on additional relevant variables (i.e., incident type and location) were assumed to represent data entry errors. One hundred twelve schools had at least one instance of a suspected duplicate entry. In most instances the suspected duplicate entries represented only two entries for one incident. However, some incidents appear to have been duplicated multiple times. It is hypothesized that this occurred when an incident code was assigned to each *individual* involved in an incident, instead of having one incident code assigned to each incident. These instances were unduplicated by removing the repeated cases from the data set. In this manner, a total of 780 duplicate cases were eliminated. Appendix A represents the 18 schools that had more than 10 instances where a duplicate entry was suspected, as well as the number of incidents reported for those schools, the number of suspected duplicate instances, and the number of *additional* incidents that were recorded as suspected duplicates and removed from the 2006-07 count. The list includes six high schools, eight middle schools, two elementary schools, and two centers. Six of the 18 schools (represented in bold) are Superintendent’s Schools in 2007-08.

Findings

District Incident Rate

Table 1 provides the total number of incidents reported at schools, during school-sponsored activities, or on school-sponsored transportation for the years 2004-05 through 2006-07. There were 9,718 incidents reported in BCPS for the 2006-07 school year, which represents a rate of 37.0 incidents for every 1,000 students. These

figures signify an increase in both total number and rate over the previous two years. The new Bullying/Harassment code accounted for 871 additional incidents which would have been coded in 2005-06 as local incidents. Beyond that, it is not possible to determine whether the additional incidents reported represent an increase in the number of actual incidents or a change in reporting practices at school sites.

Incident Rates by School Level

Incident rates varied by school type and level. Table 2 presents incident rates by school type and level for the past three years. Although centers had the fewest number of total incidents for each school year, due to the relatively smaller number of students, they consistently had the highest incident rate for every 1,000 students. Middle schools evidenced the second

highest rate, followed by high schools and elementary schools, respectively. From 2004-05 to 2005-06, the incident rates declined at the elementary, middle, and high school levels and increased at centers. From 2005-06 to 2006-07 this pattern reversed with increases seen at elementary, middle, and high school levels and a decrease at centers. Incident rates at individual school locations are presented in Appendix B.

Incident Rates by Category of Incident

For the purpose of the present report, incidents were grouped into four primary categories.

- Crimes Against Persons included Battery, Fighting, Kidnapping, Robbery, Sexual Battery, Sexual Harassment, Sexual Offenses/Other, Threat/Intimidation, and Bullying/Harassment. No homicides were reported.
- Property Offenses included Arson, Breaking and Entering/Burglary, Larceny/Theft (items valued at \$300 or more), and Vandalism (items/repairs valued at \$1,000 or more).
- Alcohol, Tobacco, and Other Drug Offenses (ATOD) included the use, possession, sale and/or distribution of alcohol, tobacco, and/or drugs.
- Other Offenses included Trespassing, Weapons Possession, Disturbance on Campus, and Unclassified/Other Major Offenses.

Table 3 represents that, in each of the three years examined, the most frequently reported incidents were Crimes Against Persons. The second most commonly reported incidents were categorized as Other Offenses. Both ATOD and Property Offenses occurred at lower rates, compared to the prior school years. Rates for

2006-07 were higher than 2005-06 for Crimes Against Persons and Other Offenses. Some of the increase in Crimes Against Persons can be attributed to the addition of the Bullying/Harassment code in 2006-07.

Table 4 reflects incident rates by both category and specific incident type. Within the Crimes Against Persons category, increases were seen in 2006-07 for Battery, Fighting, and Threat-Intimidation. Fighting incidents accounted for the highest rate in this category. Property incidents most often involved Larceny/Theft. Within the ATOD category, drug offenses were most common followed by tobacco offenses. These trends held true for each of the three years. Finally, “Unclassified/Other Major” and “Disruption on Campus–Major” represented the largest proportions of incidents within the Other Offenses category in 2006-07. These figures are similar to those reported last year. Disorderly Conduct had been the most commonly reported offense in this category in 2004-05, which was the last year that this category of offense was classified as a SESIR incident.

Patterns of Incidents by School Level

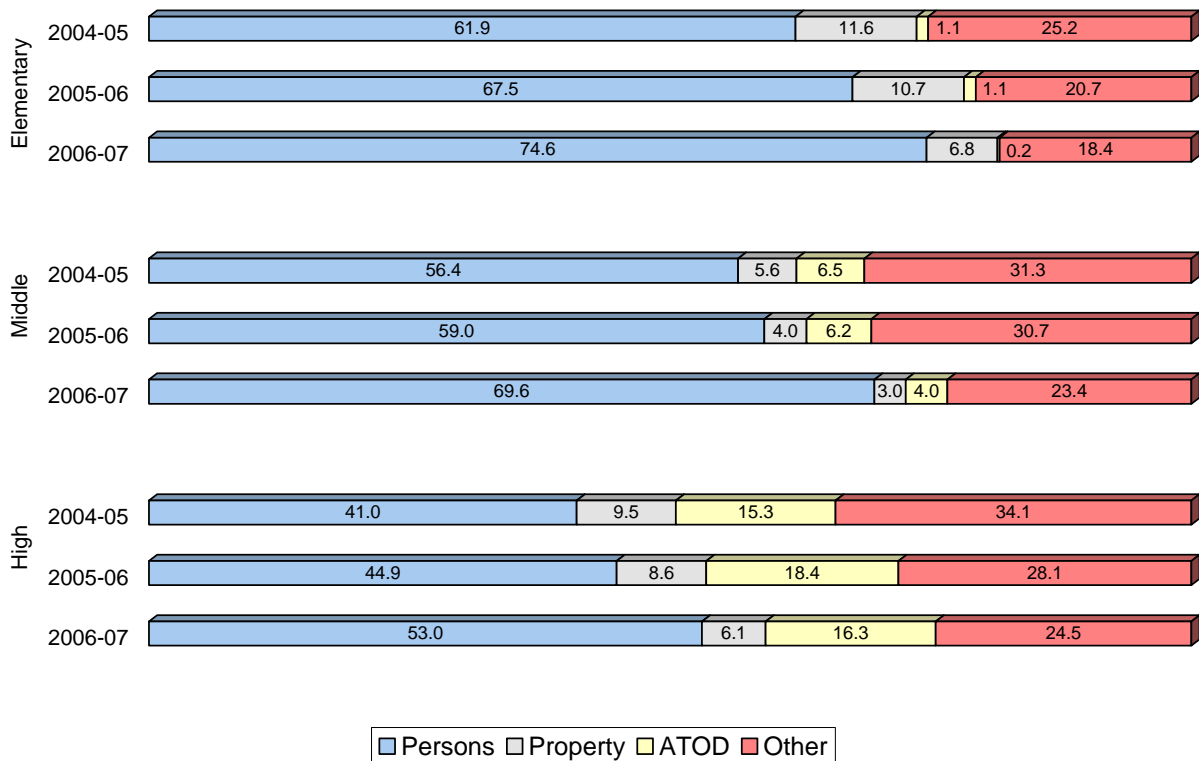


Figure 1. Proportion of total incidents within category by school level, 2004-05 through 2006-07.

Figure 1 depicts the proportion of incidents falling within each of the four incident categories disaggregated by school level for elementary, middle, and high schools. At each school level, the most commonly reported incidents were Crimes Against Persons, followed by

Other Offenses. At all levels, the proportion of Crimes Against Persons has increased each year while the percentages of incidents categorized as Property and Other Offenses have decreased. Again, some of the increase represented in Crimes Against Persons is attributable to the addition of the Bullying/Harassment code, but increases in Fighting, Battery, and Threat/Intimidation were also a factor. The proportion of ATOD Offenses is highest in high school and lowest in elementary school. However, the proportion of Property Offenses is highest at the elementary level and lowest at the middle school level.

Pattern of Incidents by Type of Incident

Table 5 displays the number of incidents reported in the past three years, disaggregated by the type of incident, along with the percentage that each type of incident contributed to the total number of incidents reported. The data reflect that the proportions of incidents within a category remained relatively consistent across years. Crimes Against Persons represented more than half of all reported incidents across all three years with Fighting (range 28.3% to 30.2%) and Battery (range 11.2% to 12.8%) accounting for the majority. Incidents reported in this category have risen steadily across the three years from 51% in 2004-05 to 64.2% in 2006-07. Again, the 2006-07 addition of the Bullying/Harassment category accounts for a portion of this increase. Other Offenses, which have decreased steadily across the three years from 31.0% in 2004-05 to 23.2% in 2006-07, constitute approximately one quarter of the total. The 2005-06 removal of Disorderly Conduct and addition of Disruption on Campus–Major make it impossible to compare

across years for this category of incidents. However, Trespassing and Weapons Possession incidents have decreased steadily across the three years. Unclassified/Other Major incidents in 2006-07 were increased over 2005-06 but still lower than figures reported in 2004-05. ATOD Offenses constituted only 7.5% of all incidents in 2006-07 which also reflected the lowest total across the three years. Property Offenses also decreased across the three years, with the lowest number and percentage ($n=492$, 5.1%) being reported in 2006-07. Each year approximately half of the reported Property Offenses are attributable to Larceny/Theft.

Primary Characteristics of Incidents

The SESIR system also allows for the capture of information on the primary characteristics of an incident including who was involved, where the incident occurred, and when the incident occurred. These characteristics of incidents have historically reflected little variability across school years. The data for 2006-07 continued the pattern where the vast majority of incidents were committed by students (94.8%), on campus (98.1%), and during normal school hours (96.6%).

Incidents may be coded as involving students, non-students, employees, or unknown individuals, with an additional code designating incidents that involve both students and non-students. In 2006-07, only 3.2% of all incidents reported were committed by unknown persons. The most common incidents attributed to unknown individuals were Property Offenses—specifically Larceny/Theft and Vandalism. This is not surprising given that thefts and vandalism often occur in the evenings or on weekends and are not immediately detected by school staff. Indeed, of the 492 Property Offenses in 2006-07, 236 (48%) of these cases were coded as involving an unknown individual.

Although SESIR codes capture specific information regarding the location of each incident, locations are also categorized broadly in terms of whether they occurred on school grounds, on school-sponsored transportation, or at an off-campus school-sponsored activity. Consistent with the fact that most incidents involved students and occurred during the school day, the vast majority ($n=9,536$, 98.1%) of the incidents occurred on school grounds. Of the remaining incidents, those occurring on school-sponsored transportation ($n=104$, 1.1%) were slightly more common than those occurring off campus ($n=78$, 0.8%). In 2006-07, of the 9,536 incidents that occurred on campus, the largest numbers of incidents were recorded as having happened in the classroom ($n=4,667$, 48.9%), hallways ($n=1,049$, 11.0%), cafeteria ($n=667$, 7.0%), and more general student areas ($n=558$, 5.9%). For 833 (8.7%) of the 2006-07 on-campus incidents, no specific location code was entered.

Similarly, while schools document the exact time of day that incidents occur, the time of the incident is also coded more generally as “During School Hours” or “Outside School Hours.” The “During School Hours” code has been defined as the time when instruction and learning was taking place within the school. “Outside School Hours” designates any time when instruction was not taking place or when the normal school day was not in session. The “Outside School Hours” designation is further broken down to distinguish those after-hours incidents that occurred at school-sponsored activities from other after-hours incidents. As would be expected, the overwhelming majority (96.6%) of 2006-07 incidents occurred during the school day. Examination of the types of incidents that occurred Outside School Hours in 2006-07 indicates that, of the 133 incidents that occurred Outside School Hours at school-sponsored events, the highest number and percentage were recorded as Fighting ($n=34$, 25.6%), Battery ($n=15$, 11.3%), and Alcohol-related ($n=15$, 11.3%) incidents, while after-hours incidents *not* associated with school sponsored events were more likely to be Larceny/Theft ($n=37$, 27.8%) or Breaking and Entering/Burglary ($n=31$, 23.3%).

Related Elements

The SESIR system also allows for the capture of supplemental information (i.e., “related elements,” FDOE, 2006c) that provides additional background information for any incident. Prior to 2006-07, related elements defined incidents that were alcohol-related, drug-related, gang-related, hate-related, or weapon-related. For example, a gang-motivated fight involving weapons would be captured with a primary offense code of Fighting and would also be flagged as gang-related and weapon-related. A single incident may be coded with more than one related element when appropriate. In 2006-07, “bullying-related” was added as a sixth related element (FDOE, 2006e; Rill & Meldrum, 2007).

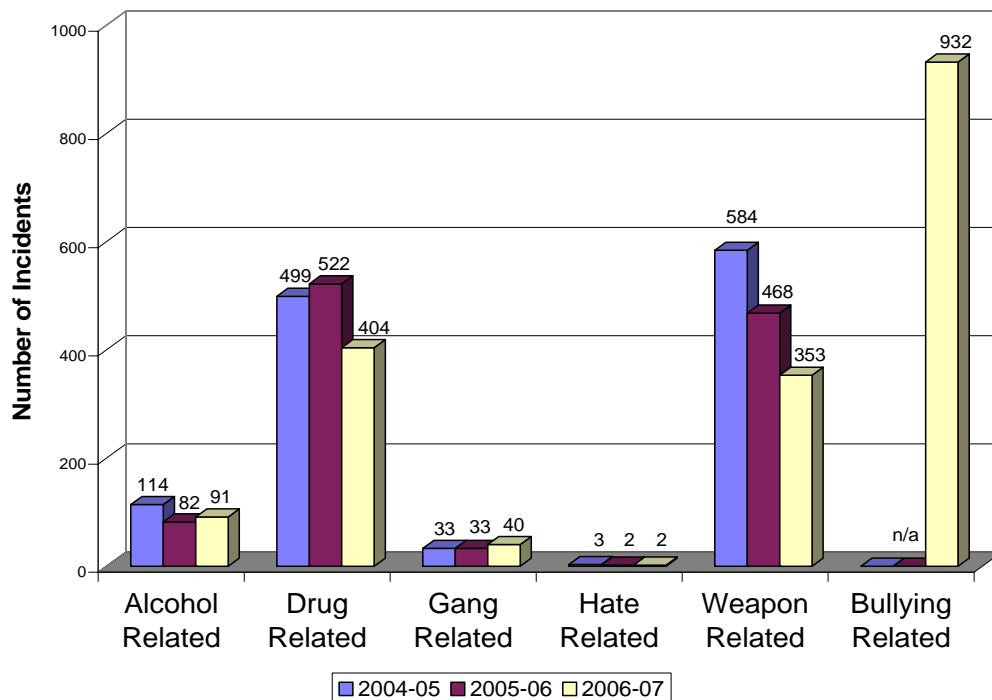


Figure 2. Number of incidents related to alcohol, drugs, hate crimes, gangs, weapons, or bullying, 2004-05 through 2006-07.

Figure 2 displays the number of incidents in each of the three years that involved any of the six related elements. Because it was possible for one incident to involve multiple related elements, these figures include some number of duplicate counts. Alcohol-related, drug-related, gang-related, hate-related, and bullying-related data each represent the number of *incidents* that were flagged with the code for that related element. The weapon-related data, however, were drawn from the field that codes the actual weapon that was reported as being involved in weapon-related incidents. Despite the fact that every weapon possession incident should be coded as weapon-related (FDOE, 2006e), 353 incidents included a code indicating that a specific weapon had been involved, although only seven incidents were coded as being weapon-related. Of the 871 incidents coded as Bullying/Harassment (BHA), 860 (98.7%) were also appropriately coded as being bullying-related. An additional 59 non-BHA incidents were also coded as being bullying-related. These bullying-related non-BHA Primary Incidents were coded as Battery ($n=25$), Disruption on Campus—Major ($n=2$), Fighting ($n=16$), Unclassified/Other Major ($n=8$), Sexual Harassment ($n=2$), and Threat/Intimidation ($n=6$).

Overall, 18.5% ($n=1,795$) of the District’s total incidents in 2006-07 involved *one or more* of the six related elements. Less than 0.01% ($n=14$) of the incidents coded with a related element were coded with two related elements. No incident was coded with more than two related elements. In 2006-07, the largest number of related elements reported were bullying-related. Across all years, drug-related and weapon-related incidents occurred considerably more frequently than alcohol-related, gang-related, or hate-related incidents. However, in 2006-07, a substantial reduction was observed in the reporting of both drug-related and weapon-related incidents. A small increase was observed in alcohol-related and gang-related incidents, although those numbers remain small. The number of hate-related incidents reported across the years has been consistent and very small (2 to 3).

Only a small number of the incidents reported in 2006-07 involved weapons ($n=353$, 3.6%). Table 6 reflects the types of weapons that were involved in weapon-related incidents from 2004-05 to 2006-07. For each school year, knives (which include razor blades) accounted for more than 60% of all weapons, while the Other Weapons category accounted for approximately one-quarter of reported weapons. Weapons classified in the latter category included BB guns, chemical devices or chemical explosives, fireworks/firecrackers, and any other object used as a weapon (e.g., scissors or a pen used as a stabbing instrument). In 2006-07, less than one percent ($n=3$) of all weapon incidents involved any type of gun.

Incidents Reported to Law Enforcement

The 2006-07 FDOE guidelines (rev. July 2006) required law enforcement notification for most incident types (FDOE, 2006b). According to the guidelines, “**Reported to Law Enforcement**’ means that an official action was taken by a School Resource Office (SRO) or local law enforcement officer such as: a case number was assigned, a report was filed, an affidavit was filed, an investigation was conducted, or an arrest was made. The presence of, or consultation with, a law enforcement officer or SRO is not sufficient for an incident to be coded as **Reported to Law Enforcement.**” (p. P-11). The FDOE Definitions for Incident Reporting distinguish between SESIR incidents that “ARE EXPECTED to be reported to law enforcement” and those that “MAY NOT NEED to be reported to law enforcement” (p. P-11). Only three SESIR incidents—Fighting, Sexual Harassment, and Bullying/Harassment—fall in the latter category.

According to the guidelines set forth by the BCPS Special Investigative Unit (SIU) in the District's Discipline Matrix (08/16/06 revision), referral to the District's SIU and/or Local Law Enforcement is mandatory for all SESIR incidents with the exception of Bullying/Harassment. However, the Discipline Matrix stipulates 40 specific incidents that are reported to the state as opposed to the 22 incident types defined by FDOE, which makes analysis related to compliance difficult. That is, there are incidents for which the state does not require notification (e.g., fighting and sexual harassment) that are still reportable to SIU or law enforcement according to District guidelines. The obligation to notify SIU is satisfied by a school's completion and submission of an SIU Immediate Notification Form.

Table 7 depicts aggregate data that reflect the number and percentage of each type of incident that was reported either to SIU, to outside law enforcement, or both over the three years of this report. In 2006-07, 2,380 (24.5%) of the 9,718 SESIR incidents were coded as having been reported. However, approximately 3,093 (31.8%) incidents were actually reported to SIU through the submission of an Immediate Notification Form (personal communication, October 15, 2007). This discrepancy suggests that schools are not properly coding incidents that are actually being reported. However, the larger problem appears to be that schools are also not reporting incidents that are reportable under SESIR and/or District guidelines.

As Table 7 indicates, only a small portion of the total SESIR incidents were documented in TERMS as being reported to law enforcement in any given year (range 24.5% to 28.3%). The category of offenses that were most often reported to law enforcement in 2006-07 were Property Offenses (73.6%), followed by ATOD (47.4%), and Other Offenses (28.7%). Crimes Against Persons were the least likely to be reported (16.4%). This overall pattern was consistent over the three years of this report. Examination of the data related to specific types of incidents revealed that in 2006-07 Breaking and Entering/Burglary (89.2%), Sexual Battery (81.8%), and Larceny/Theft (79.5%), were most likely to be reported to law enforcement. Besides Bullying/Harassment (2.4%), which is not reportable under either the state or District guidelines, the types of incidents least likely to be reported to law enforcement included Fighting (7.1%), Disruption on Campus—Major (17.9%), and Tobacco Offenses (18.3%).

The low correspondence between incidents reported to the state through SESIR and incidents reported to law enforcement has been an ongoing issue for BCPS. The state has historically identified BCPS as the school district with the worst correspondence rate (Rill, 2005, The School Board of Broward County, 2006b). This issue has been addressed in each previous version of this report (2001-06), both as a finding and as an area requiring further action. To address this continuing problem, the District has developed a new Discipline Management System that meets the state reporting requirements within a more user-friendly format that captures data related to behavior in much the same manner that the system captures academic information. The new system was developed through a collaborative process that included staff based in the schools, ETS, Student Support Services, and Human Resource Development. As of October 1, 2007, the new Discipline Management System is being piloted in 25 District schools.

Summary

This report examined the frequency and type of incidents occurring at schools, at school-sponsored activities, or on school-sponsored transportation for the years 2004-05 through 2006-07. Results revealed the following key findings.

- In 2006-07, there were 9,718 reported incidents, corresponding to a rate of 37.0 incidents for every 1,000 students. This increase over last year is at least partially accounted for by the elevation of Bullying/Harassment from the status of a local event to that of a SESIR event in 2006-07.
- The 2006-07 data indicate that there were increases in the incident rate at elementary, middle, and high schools and decreases at District centers.
- The most frequently reported incidents were categorized as Crimes Against Persons with the most commonly reported incident being Fighting.
- The proportions of incidents within a category (Crimes Against Persons, Other Offenses, Alcohol/Tobacco/Drug Offenses, and Property Offenses) remained relatively consistent across years.
- In 2006-07, as in previous years, the vast majority of incidents were committed by students (94.8%), on campus (98.1%), and during normal school hours (96.6%). Only 3.2% of all incidents reported were committed by unknown persons.
- Across all years, drug-related and weapon-related incidents occurred considerably more frequently than alcohol-related, gang-related, or hate-related incidents, although the number of incidents related to *any* of these elements amounted to only nine percent of the total. In 2006-07, a substantial reduction was observed in the reporting of both drug-related and weapon-related incidents. A small increase was observed in alcohol-related and gang-related incidents, although those numbers remain small. Again, this year only two hate-related incidents were reported. This is the first year that bullying-related was captured as a SESIR related element.
- Only 3.6% of all incidents reported in 2006-07 involved weapons. As in previous years, knives (including razor blades) accounted for more than 60% of all weapons, while the Other Weapons category accounted for approximately one-quarter of reported weapons. Less than one percent of weapon incidents involved any type of gun.
- Again this year, only a small portion of the total SESIR incidents were documented in TERMS as being reported to law enforcement (24.5%). This discrepancy has been addressed in six previous versions of this report, with no discernable improvement over time. In an effort to address this continuing problem, the District has developed a new Discipline Management System through a collaborative process that included staff based in the schools, ETS, Student Support Services, and Human Resource Development. As of October 1, 2007, the new Discipline Management System is being piloted in 25 District schools.

Further Actions

The accuracy of data is critical. In order to facilitate accurate data reporting and maximize the utility of the data presented in this report, the following actions will be implemented.

1. Appendix B provides school-by-school data for the total number of incidents, as well as specific types of incidents for the past three years. Z-scores were computed based on the number of incidents to provide a relative index of the incident rates across schools within school levels. In 2006-07, schools reporting no incidents included 16 charter schools (11 elementary, two middle, and three high schools) and eight traditional elementary schools. Z-scores are not reported for schools reporting zero incidents. Area Directors and school principals should examine incident numbers and rates for their individual schools to identify areas of concern. Schools with zero incidents or extreme z-scores (lower than -2 or higher than +2) will examine their data collection procedures to ensure compliance with reporting guidelines. Schools with stable patterns of high incident rates will work with SIU staff, Student Support Services, or their Area Director to implement specific intervention programs to reduce incidents at their school.
2. Review of the raw incident data suggests that some schools may be making data entry errors that inflate incident numbers. Errors include, but are not limited to, duplicate incident entries. Area Superintendents will be provided with a list of schools that showed a substantial number of suspected data entry errors. Within 30 days, SIU will coordinate with ETS to provide intensive professional development training for Data Processing Clerks (DPCs) and school administrators (or designees) responsible for discipline data at schools with a substantial number of suspected data errors (Appendix A). Training for staff will involve the evaluation of their own 2006-07 incident data, with the goal of increasing the accuracy of data reporting in 2007-08. Training will occur no later than the end of November 2007. For Superintendent's Schools with high incident rates and/or suspected errors, SIU will provide monthly monitoring and review of incident data through the District's Enterprise Accountability System. For non-Superintendent's Schools, SIU will identify a staff member to review incident data monthly.
3. In order to self-monitor the accuracy of their incident reporting, schools are encouraged to utilize the incident-related reports available through the Data Warehouse "School Reports" menu which provides up-to-date access to data that reflect the current status of their incident reporting. These reports allow schools to access the number of local and SESIR incidents, related elements, discipline outcomes, and the number of each type of incident reported to law enforcement or SIU.
4. ETS staff will review current incident definitions to ensure that all current SESIR incidents and related elements (e.g., bullying-related) have fields that are available for coding in the TERMS database and accessible through the Hyperion Discipline Event catalog. In addition, ETS staff will investigate the possibility of automatically populating related element fields (e.g., weapon-related or bullying-related) when possible. For example, it would facilitate the efficient and effective capture of weapons data if the weapon-related event field would be automatically populated when a weapon code has been entered.

Appendix B

Z-Score Summary of Incidents by Level, 2004-05 Through 2005-06

The attached table reflects the number of incidents that occurred at each school by school level for 2004-05, 2005-06, and 2006-07. Z-scores were computed for the total number of incidents and for categories including Crimes Against Persons, Property Offenses, Alcohol/Tobacco/Drug Offenses (ATOD), and Other Offenses. **These z-scores were calculated separately for each school level based on the number of incidents at that school level.** Therefore, the z-scores provide a relative index of the number of incidents across schools within a level. Due to the unique characteristics of students attending centers, z-scores were not computed for these sites. As a result, the total number of incidents will not match the total of 9,718 reported for 2006-07.

A z-score of zero indicates that the school had a number of discipline incidents that fell within the average range. A positive z-score indicates a higher-than-average number of discipline incidents. A negative z-score indicates a lower-than-average number of incidents. Z-scores are omitted for schools reporting zero incidents. Extreme z-scores (lower than -2 or higher than +2) are highlighted. However, extreme z-scores are not highlighted in any instance where there were less than 10 total incidents or less than five incidents in any category. If a z-score is highlighted, schools should examine the incidents in that category to determine whether particularly high or low numbers suggest that changes in data collection procedures and/or the implementation of interventions to increase safety may be warranted. If no z-scores are highlighted, it indicates that the incident rates were not substantially different from other schools at that school level. However, schools should still examine the number of incidents occurring within each specific category for any totals that appear to be high. Again, if a number is high, schools may wish to examine their data collection procedures and/or implement appropriate interventions to increase safety.

The following is a key to the abbreviations for incidents within categories.

Crimes Against Persons: BAT=Battery, BHA=Bullying/Harassment, FIT=Fighting, HOM=Homicide, KID=Kidnapping, ROB=Robbery, SXB=Sexual Battery, SXH=Sexual Harassment, SXO=Sexual Offense/Other, TRE=Threat/Intimidation

Property Offenses: ARS=Arson, BRK=Breaking and Entering/Burglary, MVT=Motor Vehicle Theft (2005 only), STL=Larceny/Theft, VAN=Vandalism

ATOD Offenses: ALC=Alcohol, TBC=Tobacco, DRG=Drugs (includes DRD=Drug Sale/Distribution--Excluding Alcohol & DRU=Drug Use/Possession--Excluding Alcohol in 2005-06 and 2006-07)
