SUBJECT: EXAMINATION OF POST-SECONDARY READINESS COMPONENT OF HIGH SCHOOL GRADING FORMULA

Research Services staff has examined the post-secondary readiness component of the new high school grading formula that took effect in the 2009-10 school year. Initial results from Broward’s review of the post-secondary readiness examination were released to Area Superintendents on December 1, 2009, with a follow-up on February 5, 2010. This memorandum provides a final update of graduating seniors in 2009-10 and identifies future seniors in 2010-11 who have yet to meet the post-secondary readiness criteria, so that schools can target their efforts to improve their performance in this component once the 2010-11 school year begins. Data from all administrations of the SAT, ACT, and CPT for the 2009-10 school year have been included in this report. The data for this update was retrieved from the Data Warehouse on July 20, 2010.

The post-secondary readiness component is defined as follows for the 2009-10 school year.

Numerator	Denominator*
Number of students scoring “ready” on SAT, ACT, and/or Common Placement Test (CPT) any time during their high school careers	On-time high school graduates who scored a Level 3 or higher on the 10 th Grade FCAT

* The denominator will change to **all on-time high school graduates** in 2011-12.

According to Florida Administrative Code (FAC) 6A-10.0315, students must meet or exceed the following scores to be defined as scoring “ready” on the SAT, ACT, or CPT.

SAT	ACT	CPT
Verbal, 440	Reading, 18	Reading, 83
Mathematics, 440	Mathematics, 19	Mathematics, 72

Final Review of Post-Secondary Readiness Component for 2009-10 Seniors

The final review examined post-secondary readiness for all 2009-10 seniors who received a graduation withdrawal code, who enrolled in 9th grade for the first time in 2006-07, and who scored at Achievement Level 3 or higher on the 10th grade FCAT. *It is important to note that this is a best guess estimate of the post-secondary readiness component of the high school grade and does not reflect the actual points schools will receive from the FDOE for the post-secondary readiness component.* All students who graduated and who had FCAT scores Level 3 or higher were included, even those who attended schools that did not receive a grade. Appendices A and B illustrate the 2009-10 estimated standing in this component for schools. Appendix A shows the number and percentage of students by school who have met the “ready” score on the SAT, ACT, or CPT. Appendix B lists the number and percentage of students who have either not taken or not passed the SAT, ACT, or CPT. Overall, findings were as follows.

Mathematics:

- Sixty-five percent ($n=7,812$ out of 12,035) of students who registered a graduation withdrawal code in 2009-10 and scored at Level 3 or higher on the FCAT-SSS Mathematics subtest met the mathematics readiness score on the SAT, ACT, or CPT.
- Eight percent ($n=978$) of these graduates who were proficient in mathematics had not taken any of the tests.
- Twenty-seven percent ($n=3,245$) of these graduates took either the SAT, ACT, or CPT, but did not meet the mathematics readiness score.

Reading:

- Almost eighty-four percent (83.7%, $n=6,224$ out of 7,436) of students who registered a graduation withdrawal code in 2009-10 and scored at Level 3 or higher on FCAT-SSS Reading subtest met the reading readiness score on the SAT, ACT, or CPT.
- About seven percent (6.8%, $n=508$) of these graduates had not taken any of the tests.
- Almost ten percent (9.5%, $n=704$) of these students took either the SAT, ACT, or CPT, but did not meet the reading readiness score.

Preliminary Review of Post-Secondary Readiness Component for 2010-11 Seniors

As a preview for next year’s seniors, the preliminary review examined post-secondary readiness for all 2010-11 upcoming seniors who enrolled in 9th grade for the first time in 2007-08, who have scored at Achievement Level 3 or higher on the 10th grade FCAT, and who have not yet met the post-secondary readiness criteria. These students either have not met the readiness score, or have not taken either the SAT, ACT, or CPT, as of July 2010. All students with FCAT scores Level 3 or higher were included, even those at schools that did not receive a grade. Note, the data were retrieved from the Data Warehouse prior to the start of the 2010-11 school year, and therefore, only include students who indicated they were planning to return to Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) as a 12th grade student. Appendices C and D illustrate the 2010-11 estimated standing in this component for schools. Appendix C shows the number and percentage of students by school who have met the “ready” score on the SAT, ACT, or CPT. Appendix D lists the number and percentage of students who have either not taken or not passed the SAT, ACT, or CPT. Overall, preliminary findings for 2010-11 seniors were as follows.

Mathematics:

- Forty-two percent (42.3%, $n=5,569$ out of 13,176) of 2010-11 upcoming senior students who scored at Level 3 or higher on the FCAT-SSS Mathematics subtest met the mathematics readiness score on the SAT, ACT, or CPT.
- Twenty-five percent ($n=3,328$) of these students have yet to take any of the tests.
- Almost thirty-three percent (32.5%, $n=4,279$) of these students took either the SAT, ACT, or CPT, but have not yet met the mathematics readiness score.

Reading:

- Sixty-four ($n=4,868$ out of 7,575) of 2010-11 upcoming senior students who scored at Level 3 or higher on FCAT-SSS Reading subtest met the reading readiness score on the SAT, ACT, or CPT.
- Twenty-two percent ($n=1,684$) of these students have yet to take any of the tests.
- Almost fourteen percent (13.5%, $n=1,023$) of these students took either the SAT, ACT, or CPT, but have not yet met the reading readiness score.

Action:

A school-by-school list of the 2010-11 seniors who scored at Level 3 or higher on the 10th grade FCAT, and who have not yet met the post-secondary readiness criteria in either mathematics or reading as of July 2010, will be available in the DWH Reports Folder by Wednesday, August 4, 2010. The list includes students who have not yet taken either the SAT, ACT, or CPT, as well as students who took any of these tests but did not reach the readiness score. Note that the 2010-11 seniors included in this list may over-represent the pool of students that will count in the post-secondary readiness component for 2010-11 high school grades, as it includes all students who may graduate on time, and also those who may not graduate in 2010-11 for any reason (i.e., did not meet GPA or credits criteria). Additionally, since this list was created prior to the start of the 2010-11 school year, it represents only students who indicated they were planning to return to BCPS as a 12th grade student. Given that future seniors can still take and pass the SAT, ACT, or CPT examinations, the preliminary assessment of the 2010-11 post-secondary readiness component will differ from the final figures.

Next Steps:

1. At the start of the 2010-11 school year, guidance directors will download the list of students who have not met the readiness scores that is available in the DWH Reports Folder, and contact each student to encourage participation in upcoming SAT or ACT administrations. Staff should remind students on free and/or reduced-priced lunch of available fee waivers.
2. In addition to the static lists provided on the DWH Reports Folder, real-time listings of students who have not taken either the SAT, ACT, or CPT, as well as students who took any of these tests but did not reach the readiness score can be accessed through the DWH School Reports Menu in the Guidance folder (GUII009 – High School College Level Math Cohort and GUII010 – High School College Level Reading Cohort).
3. The CPT (Accuplacer) was implemented at all high schools, centers, and charter schools via BCPS personnel beginning in February 2010, due to a Memorandum of Understanding with Broward College. Typically, the local community college is the only

entity authorized to administer the CPT. However, according to the FDOE, a new assessment called the Florida Postsecondary Education Readiness Test (PERT) will replace Accuplacer for the 2010-11 school year. “The Florida College System announced today that it will develop, deliver and score a dynamic new Florida Postsecondary Education Readiness Test (PERT) that will be used to better gauge a student’s readiness for college and accurately place students in classes to increase their progression rates and help them graduate sooner” (http://www.fldoe.org/news/2010/2010_05_05-3.asp). The PERT assessment will be a computer-based assessment. As indicated by an e-mail correspondence with Ralph Aiello, Coordinator of Guidance, BRACE, & Academic Advisement on June 29, 2010, any remaining Accuplacer materials will still be acceptable for the CPT, and schools will continue to administer the Accuplacer, until their supplies are exhausted. Certain students will be eligible to take the PERT; however, a window for administration has not yet been finalized.

4. The status of the post-secondary readiness component will be reexamined by December 1, 2010, once ACT and SAT results are available for future administrations. According to the College Board Web site (<http://sat.collegeboard.com/register/sat-dates>), there are seven SAT administrations (October 9th, November 6th, December 4th, January 22nd, March 12th, May 7th, and June 4th), during the 2010-11 school year. According to the ACT Web site (<http://www.actstudent.org/regist/dates.html>), there are six ACT administrations, during the 2010-11 school year (September 11th, October 23rd, December 11th, February 12th, April 9th, and June 11th). Thus, the 2010-11 seniors have several opportunities to take these tests. The deadline to register for these exams are listed on the respective Web sites above and generally occur at least one month prior to test administration.
5. The formula for post-secondary readiness will change in 2011-12 to include all on-time graduates, not only those who score Level 3 or above on the FCAT. Thus, schools should also begin working with their current 10th and 11th grade students to ensure they are prepared to take the SAT, ACT, or CPT.
