

**BUILDING EVACUATION DRILLS**

EVACUATION DRILLS MUST BE HELD IN ALL SCHOOLS IN ACCORDANCE WITH FLORIDA STATUTES, STATE BOARD REGULATIONS AND SUCH POLICY AND RULES AS ARE APPROVED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT AND/OR THE BOARD.

**RULES**

Each school must hold a building evacuation drill once a calendar quarter.

1. The first evacuation drill shall be held within the first five (5) workdays after the opening date for students.
2. The remaining evacuation drills are to be held quarterly by the principal at his/her convenience.
3. Evacuation drills should not be held during inclement weather.
4. Following such evacuation drill, the principal shall file a report with the area superintendent. This report shall include the date the evacuation drill was held and the amount of time it took to evacuate the students.
