## STUDENTS MAY PERFORM SERVICES AND PRODUCE ITEMS IN THE SCHOOLS ONLY TO THE EXTENT THAT SUCH SERVICE OR PRODUCTION FURTHERS A STUDENT'S DEVELOPMENT.

## <u>RULES</u>

- 1. Costs of services performed and items produced in school shops and laboratories for nonschool use or consumption shall be borne by the user or consumer to the extent that such costs are over and above normal instructional and material costs.
- 2. Priorities for availability of services and items for nonschool use (such as servicing automobiles in vocational shops) shall be as follows:
  - a. School students
  - b. School system employees (Because of the possibility of charges of conflict of interest, this category should be utilized only with great care.
  - c. Adults other than school system employees or Board Members
- 3. Good judgment, as well as the utmost discretion, should be used at all times.
