TESTING AND RESEARCH STUDIES

TESTS AND RESEARCH DOCUMENTS OTHER THAN STANDARDIZED INTELLIGENCE, APTITUDE AND ACHIEVEMENT TESTS SHALL NOT BE SCHEDULED OR ADMINISTERED WITHOUT THE EXPRESS CONSENT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT.

PARENTS OF THE CHILDREN TO BE INVOLVED IN SUCH PROGRAMS SHALL BE ADVISED AS TO WHERE AND WHEN SUCH TESTS OR RESEARCH DOCUMENTS ARE TO BE ADMINISTERED. FURTHER, THE PARENTS SHALL BE PERMITTED TO REMOVE THEIR CHILDREN FROM SUCH PROGRAMS IF THEY SO DESIRE.

THE ABOVE STATEMENTS, HOWEVER, ARE IN NO WAY TO BE CONSTRUED AS APPLYING TO THE DAILY, WEEKLY, GRADE PERIOD, SEMESTER OR FINAL TESTS OR EXAMINATIONS PREPARED BY THE CLASSROOM TEACHERS AND COVERING SUBJECT MATTER CONTENT.

RULES

- 1. Research studies, such as Doctoral dissertations or Master's theses, shall be examined for content and acceptability, and approved by the Superintendent (designee).
- 2. Participation in such research studies shall be on a voluntary basis by either teachers or students.
- 3. No invasion of the privacy of either staff or students by such studies shall be permitted, and students' names shall not be used or identified by or in such studies, or in documents produced as a result of such research studies.
