USE OF INSTRUCTIONAL TELEVISION BY CABLE TELEVISION COMPANIES

CABLE COMPANIES MAY CABLECAST THE INSTRUCTIONAL TELEVISION PROGRAMS OF THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY'S INSTRUCTIONAL TELEVISION SYSTEM PROVIDED THEY HAVE ENTERED INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE BOARD STIPULATING THE PROVISIONS UNDER WHICH PROGRAMS(S) AND/OR MATERIAL(S) REQUIRING COPYRIGHT OR TELEVISION CLEARANCE MAY BE USED.

<u>RULES</u>

- 1. Any cable company desiring the use of instructional programming must submit a written request to the Superintendent of Schools.
- 2. All costs incurred in the receiving and cable casting of instructional television programming must be assumed by the cable company.
- 3. Each contract shall list those program series which may be used without violating copyright agreements. If other than listed programs are used, it shall be the responsibility of the cable company to arrange for the payment of clearance fees for programs containing copyrighted materials.
- 4. Cable companies shall not be permitted to connect into any receiving equipment in the Broward County Public School System.
