SUBJECT: **REVIEW OF A+ PLAN STATUS**

As you are aware, the Florida Department of Education identified 75 "A" schools, 49 "B" schools, 53 "C" schools, 16 "D" schools, and one "F" school in Broward County under the Florida A+ Plan. Data for each school has been analyzed and compared to the new 2001-2002 grading system in an effort to assist schools in improving student achievement. The document *Review of A+ Plan Status* provides schools with specific analysis of criteria they must meet in order to maintain or improve school grades. The 2001-2002 results are provided for each individual grade level in addition to the school as a whole.
